# Executive Summary

## PERFORMANCE-BASED PARKING PROGRAM AND ANNUAL PARKING CHANGES

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) uses parking occupancy data to establish and adjust on-street parking rates and hours of operations through its Performance-Based Parking Pricing Program, which was created in 2010. Guided by language in the Seattle Municipal Code, the program uses the principles of supply and demand with a goal that drivers can reliably find short-term parking near their destinations. This helps reduce the frequency of circling or "cruising" for parking, and the associated congestion and environmental impacts.

#### DATA AND PRICING

SDOT collects data annually and analyzes occupancy by paid parking area or subarea. Including different rates at the Ballard Locks during the summer, there are 34 paid parking subareas as of Spring 2018. These areas contain in total about 12,000 on-street paid parking spaces. Occupancy and rates are evaluated over three time of day periods: morning, afternoon, and evening.


Parking occupancy is determined to be in "target range" when parking is 70% to 85% occupied. In areas where parking is above or below target, SDOT generally adjusts the rate by \$0.50 increments within a rate range between \$0.50 an hour and \$5.00 an hour. Areas within 5% above or below target range are placed on the "watch list" with rate changes deferred for one year.

# Summary of 2018 Results and Changes

#### **SUMMARY OF TIME PERIOD RATE CHANGES**

Since the beginning of the program in 2010, SDOT has made over 250 changes to paid parking rates, hours when payment is required, and area time limits. SDOT moved to setting rates by time of day in 2017. The 34 paid parking areas account for a total of 92 paid parking area time periods that could change based on data collected in 2018. The 2018 data suggests the following changes:

61 area time periods with no rate changes

area time periods with rate increases

area time periods with rate decreases

area should have paid parking hours extended to 10 PM

Rate changes are planned to be implemented in fall 2018. As in previous years, SDOT plans to collect data in spring 2019 to inform rate changes for fall 2019. This report provides a summary of occupancy data for 2017 and 2018 along with 2018 planned rate changes.


# Data Collection & Analysis

#### DATA COLLECTION

Data for the 2018 annual study were collected primarily in March and April 2018 (as well as July for the Ballard Locks). Data collection occurs on typical weekdays (Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday) to represent average parking conditions. Collection dates were chosen to avoid overlap with holidays and significant area events. Hourly occupancy observations were made beginning at 8 AM and ended one or two hours after the end of paid parking in the neighborhood. In most areas, paid parking hours end at 8 PM, but paid parking in some areas ends at 4 PM, 6 PM, or 10 PM.

#### **OCCUPANCY**

Occupancy is defined as the percent of standard on-street parking spaces in which a vehicle is parked at a given time. SDOT does not formally designate or delineate individual spaces, but maintains a space inventory that would exist if spaces were marked. These spaces are based on standard parking dimensions and reflect parking restrictions near intersections, driveways, and fire hydrants. Occupancy can be over 100% as vehicles sometimes park close together or partially in illegal areas.



#### **DATA ANALYSIS**


The target occupancy, representing 1-2 open spaces available per block, is 70% to 85%. Areas and time periods with measured occupancy within this range do not receive rate changes. Areas that are within 5% above or below this range are placed on the "watch list" and rate changes are deferred for one year. Areas above 90% occupancy or below 65% are identified for rate changes within the same year. SDOT adjusts rates in \$0.50 increments between a minimum rate of \$0.50 an hour and a maximum of \$5.00 an hour.

In areas where paid parking ends at 6 PM, SDOT uses the 7 PM occupancy to consider whether paid parking hours should be extended to 8 PM. In areas where paid parking ends at 8 PM, SDOT uses occupancy in the 8 PM and 9 PM hours to consider whether paid hours should be extended to 10 PM.

Recognizing that parking occupancy varies over the course of the day, SDOT evaluates parking occupancy by time-of-day groupings. Within these, SDOT uses an average of the "middle hours" of each time-of-day rate period for consideration of rate adjustments. These are:

## Pay by Phone

SDOT offers parking payment by phone for on-street paid parking as a convenient, easy, and secure payment option. There is no additional fee for use. The service provides text message reminders when parking time is about to expire and the ability to extend parking time within existing limits.

#### **HOW TO USE PAYBYPHONE**


- 1. Download the "PayByPhone" app on a smartphone
- 2. Register for an account, which will require entry of a credit card number and license plate. Enter plate carefully as Seattle Police Department Parking Enforcement validates payment by license plate number.
- 3. When parked on a block, enter the unique **location code** which is found on the green and white PayByPhone sign






More and more people are using the PayByPhone app. As of May 2018, pay by phone accounts for almost 30% of paid parking transactions citywide.

## Pay by Plate

SDOT is in the process of migrating on-street paid parking from "pay and display" to "pay by plate." Users who pay at a pay station will go to the pay station, enter their license plate number, select the amount of time desired, and confirm the transaction. There will be no need to print and display proof of payment in a vehicle, but an optional receipt will be available. Users may also set up an online account that can save vehicle license plate numbers associated with a credit card, thus saving users from needing to key in their license plate

with every transaction. Parking session times, based on users' license plates, are stored in a secure, vendor-hosted database that Seattle Police Department Parking Enforcement can access from either License Plate Recognition (LPR) vehicles or by enforcement officers' handheld wireless devices.

Pay by phone already uses license plate information to verify payment. Moving pay stations to pay by plate keeps payment information securely in an integrated database.

# Late Night Paid Parking Hours

Based on data from the 2017 Annual Study, SDOT extended paid parking hours from ending at 8 PM to ending at 10 PM in Capitol Hill South, Capitol Hill North, and Pike-Pine, with no time limit after 5 PM. Prior to the change, data showed on-street parking was very full deep into the evening, making access for visitors and customers extremely challenging. Charging for parking during the late evening is intended to improve access and provide more reliable parking availability for people visiting Capitol Hill for restaurants, retail, and night life.

The following table compares parking occupancy in the afternoon and evening in 2017 and 2018 in these three areas.



Data from 2018 show that extending paid hours until 10 PM increased parking availability in Capitol Hill North and South, with no real change seen in parking availability in Pike-Pine.





In addition to occupancy, in spring 2018 SDOT also collected a sample of afternoon parking duration (length of stay) information for vehicles parked between 3 PM and 10 PM. With the extension of paid parking hours to 10 PM there is no time limit for vehicles that park after 5 PM. Data from the duration study indicate that parking spaces are consistently turning over for new customers and visitors, with few vehicles staying longer than three hours.

# 2018 Late Night Changes

To determine whether paid hours should be extended from ending at 8 PM to ending at 10 PM, SDOT evaluates occupancy in the 8 PM and 9 PM hours. In areas with paid hours until 10 PM, SDOT sets the rate for 5 PM - 10 PM based on the three highest occupancy hours from 5 PM through 9 PM.

The 2018 data suggests SDOT make the following changes:

## Columbia City



SDOT installed new paid parking, load zones, disabled parking, unpaid time limits, and restricted parking zone spaces in Columbia City in late 2017 following a two-year data collection and outreach effort. Data collected in 2018 for the Annual Study represent the first occupancy study in the neighborhood following area changes. This section provides information comparing parking utilization on nine blockfaces (about 65 spaces) before and after the conversion to paid parking.

Overall, data show that conversion to paid parking led to improved parking availability and slightly shorter parking durations.

#### PARKING OCCUPANCY

Prior to implementation, parking on commercial streets in Columbia City was completely full for much of the day. Following implementation of paid parking, parking is still well utilized, but drivers are much more likely to find a space. Based on the 2018 study, rates will increase from \$1 an hour to \$1.50 an hour between 5 PM and 8 PM. Rates will remain at \$1 an hour from 8 AM to 5 PM, with midday occupancy in the high watch list for 2018.



#### PARKING DURATION

In addition to occupancy, SDOT collected information on parking duration, or length of stay, before and after changing to paid parking in Columbia City.

Prior to installing paid parking, blockfaces had 2-hour unpaid time limits 7 AM - 6 PM. Paid parking was installed with 2-hour time limits, with effective hours of 8 AM - 8 PM. There are two paid blockfaces in Columbia City with a 4-hour paid time limit, one of which is included in this study (parking on the other blockface was blocked off for construction during data collection).

# 2018 Paid Area Management Changes

The Cherry Hill and First Hill paid parking areas are unique in that a significant percentage of vehicles not subject to payment routinely park in these areas. In Cherry Hill, a large percentage of vehicles display state-issued disabled parking permits. In First Hill, many vehicles display disabled parking permits or SDOT-issued Restricted Parking Zone (RPZ) 7 and 21 permits. Vehicles displaying RPZ 7 or 21 permits can park on some blocks in the First Hill paid area without observing the posted time limit or paying the posted rate. Under Washington State law, vehicles with valid disabled permits can park on-street without payment and longer than posted time limits. Cities in Washington State can post 4-hour unpaid time limits for disabled permits.

In recent years SDOT has increased the parking rate in both areas consistent with occupancy data, but rate increases have not led to increases in open spaces and availability given the high percentage of vehicles parked without payment required.









#### **CHERRY HILL**

#### **PARKING DATA**

The Cherry Hill paid parking area is small (54 spaces), and available spaces hard to find. The percentage of vehicles parked that display disabled permits is much higher than any other area in Seattle.

Parking availability in Cherry Hill is disproportionately affected by a small number of vehicles that park all day using disabled permits, which makes access difficult for all users. In 2018, 14% of all vehicles parked longer than five hours and displayed disabled permits, but the presence of these vehicles meant that 55% of the parking spaces did not regularly turn over for short-term access.

#### 2018 ACTIONS

Parking study results indicate that SDOT could increase the parking rate to \$3.50 an hour from 8 AM to 5 PM. However, based on past experiences and the data in the table above, rate changes alone are unlikely to improve parking availability. Instead, SDOT is considering other area parking management changes to more effectively improve access; and will work with the Cherry Hill neighborhood on which to implement. Options could include:



Potential Disabled Permit Time Limit Sign

- Install two new blockfaces of on-street paid parking (about 20 spaces) covering spaces adjacent to medical offices and parking garages with short-term visitor demand and high occupancy
- Install new on-street designated disabled spaces that are reserved for vehicles with disabled permits
- During paid parking hours (8 AM 8 PM, Monday - Saturday), limit all on-street paid parking spaces in Cherry Hill to 4-hour parking for holders of disabled parking permits.

These changes are intended to improve reliable short-term parking access for those with disabled permits and other visitors to the area.



#### **FIRST HILL**

#### PARKING DATA

The First Hill paid parking area is unique in two ways:

- Almost half of the paid parking spaces allow Restricted Parking Zone (RPZ) 7
  and 21 permit holders to park for up to 72 hours without observing the posted
  time limit or paying the posted rate. Parking occupancy in these RPZ/paid areas
  is at or above 100% for all observed hours, with most spaces occupied by RPZ
  permit vehicles.
- The density of hospitals and medical providers leads to a significant percentage
  of vehicles parked with disabled permits, which are not subject to parking rates
  and time limits. In the middle of the day there are over 300 vehicles parked in
  the paid parking area displaying disabled parking permits.

Combining RPZ and disabled permit vehicles, over two-thirds of vehicles parked on-street midday in the First Hill paid parking area are not subject to on-street parking rates or time limits.

#### 2018 ACTIONS

First Hill is already at the rate maximum (\$5 an hour) midday. Data from 2018 suggests SDOT increase the rate from \$4.50 an hour to \$5.00 an hour, 8 AM – 11 AM, and extend paid parking hours from 8 PM to 10 PM. Like Cherry Hill, based upon data collected, it is unlikely that these changes would increase available parking in the area. Instead of increasing the rate and extending hours in 2018, SDOT is undertaking a review of on-street parking in First Hill to consider options such as:

- Reviewing and revising blocks that allow RPZ parking
- Installing designated disabled spaces in the paid parking area, with 4-hour time limits
- · Other options to improve short-term access near hospitals and other area destinations



# Paid Parking Area Changes

The Performance-Based Parking Program uses occupancy data in existing paid parking areas to determine rate, time limit, and parking hour changes. As Seattle continues to grow, there is also a need to consider adding new areas of parking managed through time limits and/or paid parking to ensure reliable access for customers and visitors where parking demand is high.

To that end, as part of the Annual Paid Parking Study, SDOT collects parking data in a few areas each year on streets without paid parking adjacent to those with paid parking to better understand parking in the broader area. In late 2017 SDOT expanded paid parking on five new blockfaces in the Roosevelt business district based on data from the Annual Study.

In this 2018 Study, SDOT collected parking occupancy data along streets adjacent to the following paid areas: Ballard, Cherry Hill, Fremont, and Green Lake. SDOT is reviewing this data for potential paid parking expansions in early 2019. SDOT has not made final decisions about installation of expanded paid areas, and any changes will include outreach with area businesses and residents.

## COMMUNITY ACCESS AND PARKING PROGRAM AND LIGHT RAIL STATION AREAS

Separate from the Annual Paid Parking Study, SDOT's Community Access and Parking Program works to improve access and parking management in Seattle's neighborhood business districts and nearby residential areas. This work typically involves a combination of outreach and data collection, resulting in a neighborhood parking and access management plan. Neighborhood plans can include conversion of parking to paid parking, new areas of unpaid time limits, load zone changes, designated disabled parking spaces, changes to restricted parking zones, and other curbspace management strategies.

In fall 2018, this program is active in the West Seattle Junction, Uptown, the area south of downtown known as SODO, and the Madrona business district. In 2019 the Community Access and Parking Program, working in conjunction with Sound Transit, will review and update parking management in Roosevelt, the U-District, and Northgate ahead of upcoming light rail station openings.



# SDOT's Paid Parking System Data

This report provides a summary of measured occupancy data. The underlying data for all study years is available on data.seattle.gov under "Annual Parking Study Data."

In addition to measured occupancy data, SDOT is in the process of making public a data feed of "Paid Parking Occupancy Data." This calculated occupancy combines parking inventory information and parking transactions to determine an occupancy percentage for each blockface and each minute during paid parking hours. It does not include any personally identifiable information.

Unlike measured occupancy, calculated occupancy does not contain any information about vehicles that do not make a parking transaction, which can be a substantial percentage of vehicles. It does not match parking conditions on-street, but provides information on seasonal, daily, and hourly trends in parking transactions.

## Data Tables and Maps

These tables summarize occupancy and rate changes for all paid parking areas. They are followed by individual neighborhood subarea pages which provide further details for each paid area.




#### **SEATTLE NEIGHBORHOOD SUMMER 2017 RATES: MORNING**


#### **SEATTLE NEIGHBORHOOD SUMMER 2017 RATES: AFTERNOON**
