 - Multiple groups doing their own thing, naturally people will make noise and people will want to give them more space
 - Artists having the mindset to share and expand and do their thing

<u>Committee Updates</u> Briefing: Committee Chairs

- Public Art Advisory Committee (Vee) No updates were shared.
- Cultural Investments Committee (Kayla) working to refine and shape up purpose statement which has two focus areas: 1) *Providing guidance and feedback on ARTS' racially equitable grant processes & investment strategies; 2) Advocating for equitable, accessible, and inclusive cultural investments in support of the Seattle ARTS Office and the arts sector in our city and region.* Figuring out a calendar for grants throughout the year and CIC's timeline for advisory. Currently in the process of solidifying purpose statement in terms of action.
- Facilities and Equitable Development Committee (Chieko) FED advises the work of ARTS on issues of cultural space and impacts on equitable development. Committee met in-person at Daybreak Star Indian Cultural Center and discussed the purpose and work plan of SAC/FED for new member Mike Tulee, Square Feet Seattle, cultural advocacy opportunities, and how the group can help align with native communities. Mike also shared the history of Discovery Park where Daybreak Star is located.
 - The 2022 goals for FED are: 1) Advocate for BIPOC cultural space support; 2) Forging relationships with native communities to build more equitably; 3) Continue to support the Cultural Space Agency

- Paula Wondering if the Latino community can ever have its own space to celebrate arts and culture.
 - royal is willing to have a one-on-one conversation with Paula to discuss. Allie will reach out to Paula to schedule a meeting in the coming weeks. royal noted that LHPAI is always available for community to rent space for cultural gatherings.
- Amber Rose Can community members get involved in committee work?
