



Midstream Residential Electric Vehicle Charger Program Rebates and Equipment Eligibility

Seattle City Light is offering rebates on qualifying electric vehicle chargers installed through the Seattle City Light Lighting To Go program. This one-year offering begins on January 15, 2024 and runs through December 31, 2024. The intent of the program is to increase the stocking, selling, and installation of qualifying Level 2 EV Chargers. Local governments may have safety or code requirements beyond the criteria for participation in this program.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Eligibility is listed by equipment type, product type, and maximum output power (kW)
- Equipment must be compliant with the [ENERGY STAR® 1.2 Specifications](#) and be found on the AC-Output [ENERGY STAR® certified products list](#) on energystar.gov
- Chargers must be installed at a single-family property, which is one that contains only one- to four- dwelling units and receives electric service from Seattle City Light
- Chargers may be plug-in or hardwired
- Maximum Output Power of the charger must be 11.6kW or less
- Equipment must be purchased through a participating distributor
- Rebates are listed as \$/charger

Limit one electric vehicle charger per dwelling unit. Sales made between January 15, 2024, and December 31, 2024, as determined by the date on the distributor invoice to the installer, are eligible for the rebates below. Sales during this period must be submitted by January 10, 2025.
