- Harborview Medical Center is owned by King County, governed by a county-appointed board of trustees and managed by the University of Washington.
- Harborview is the only Level 1 adult and pediatric trauma center in the state of Washington.
- Serves as the regional trauma center for Alaska, Montana and Idaho

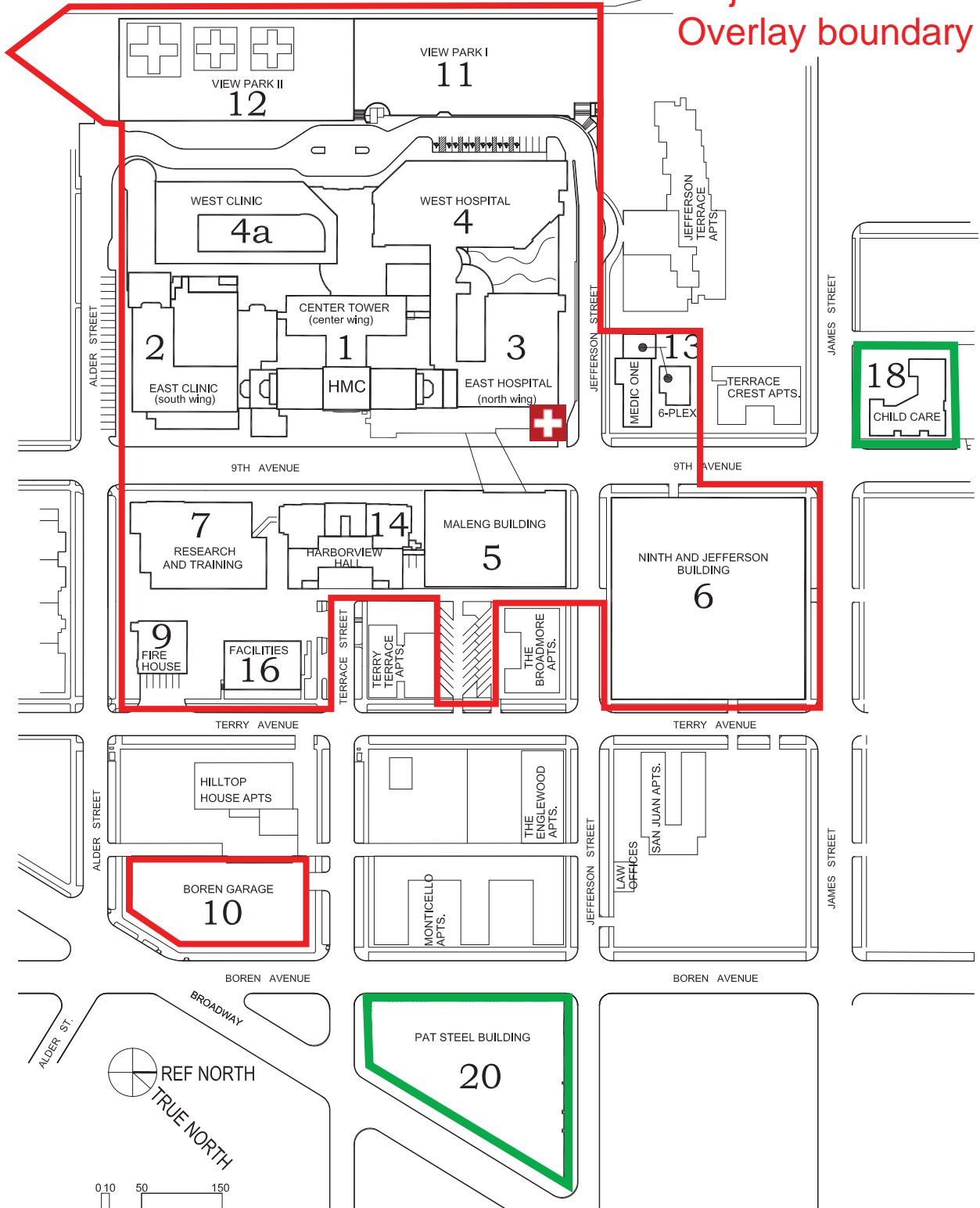
**Planned Projects – Development sites meant to be developed first.**

**The code allows for development sites to move from Potential to Planned or visa versa.**

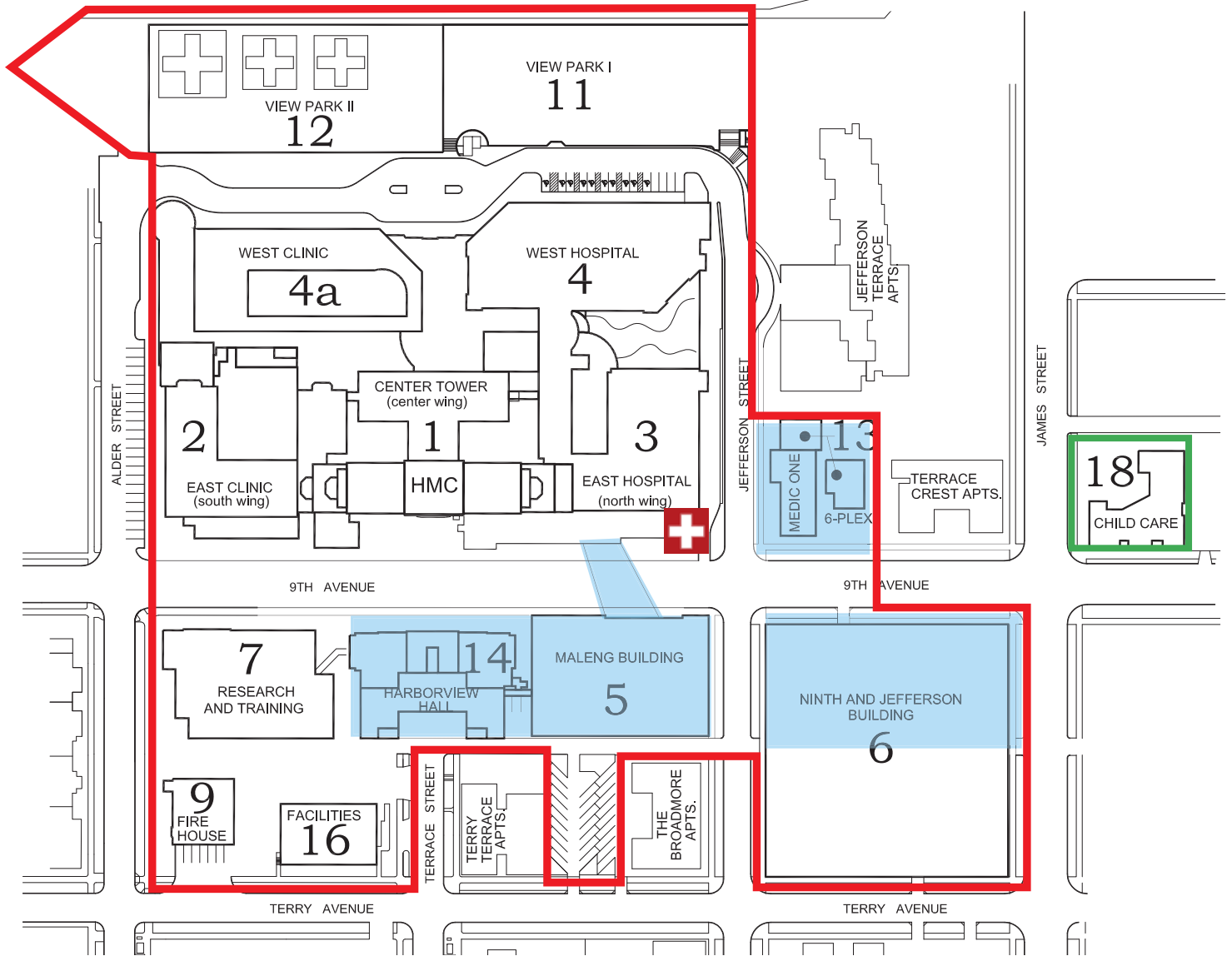
# HMC CAMPUS PLAN

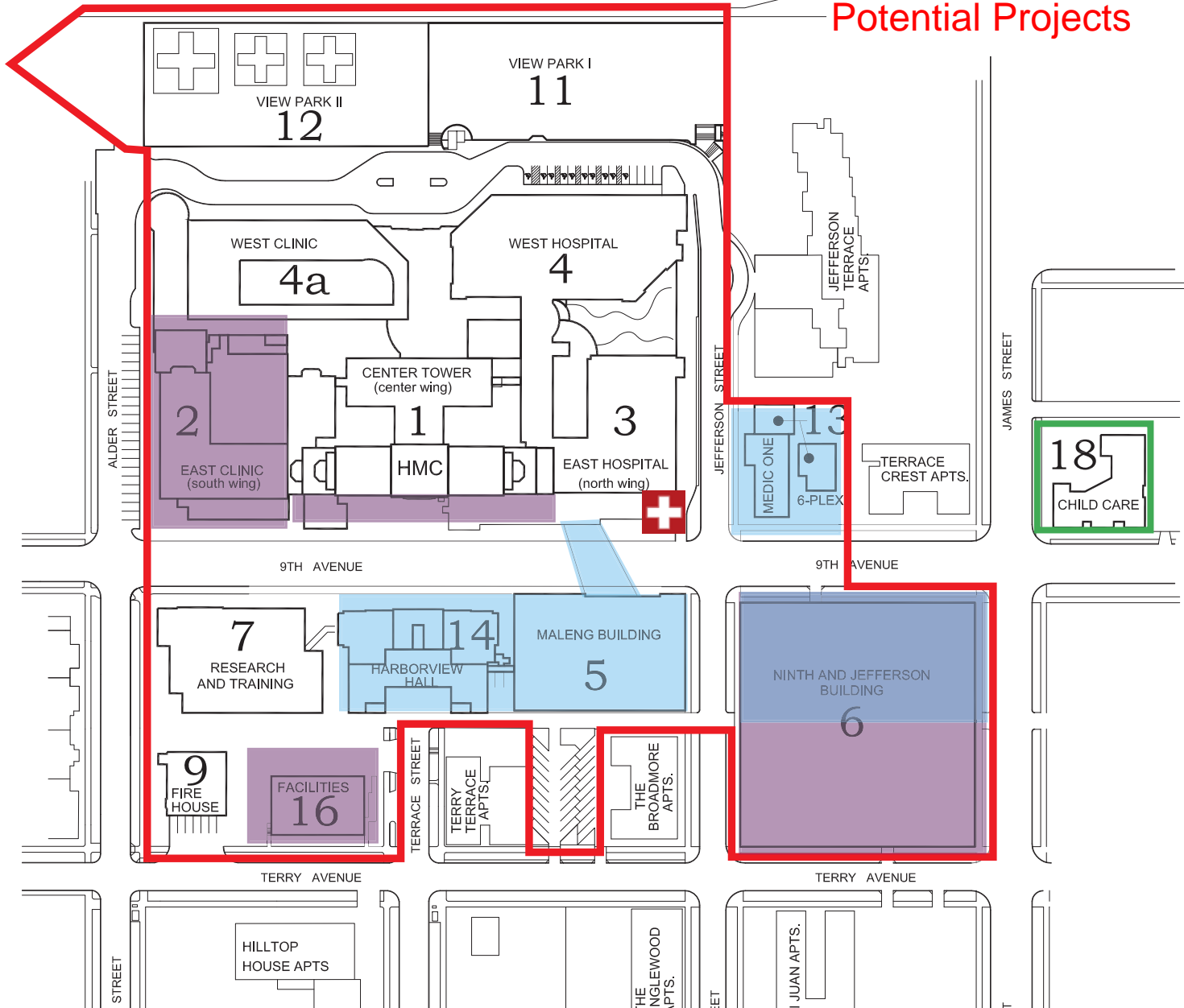

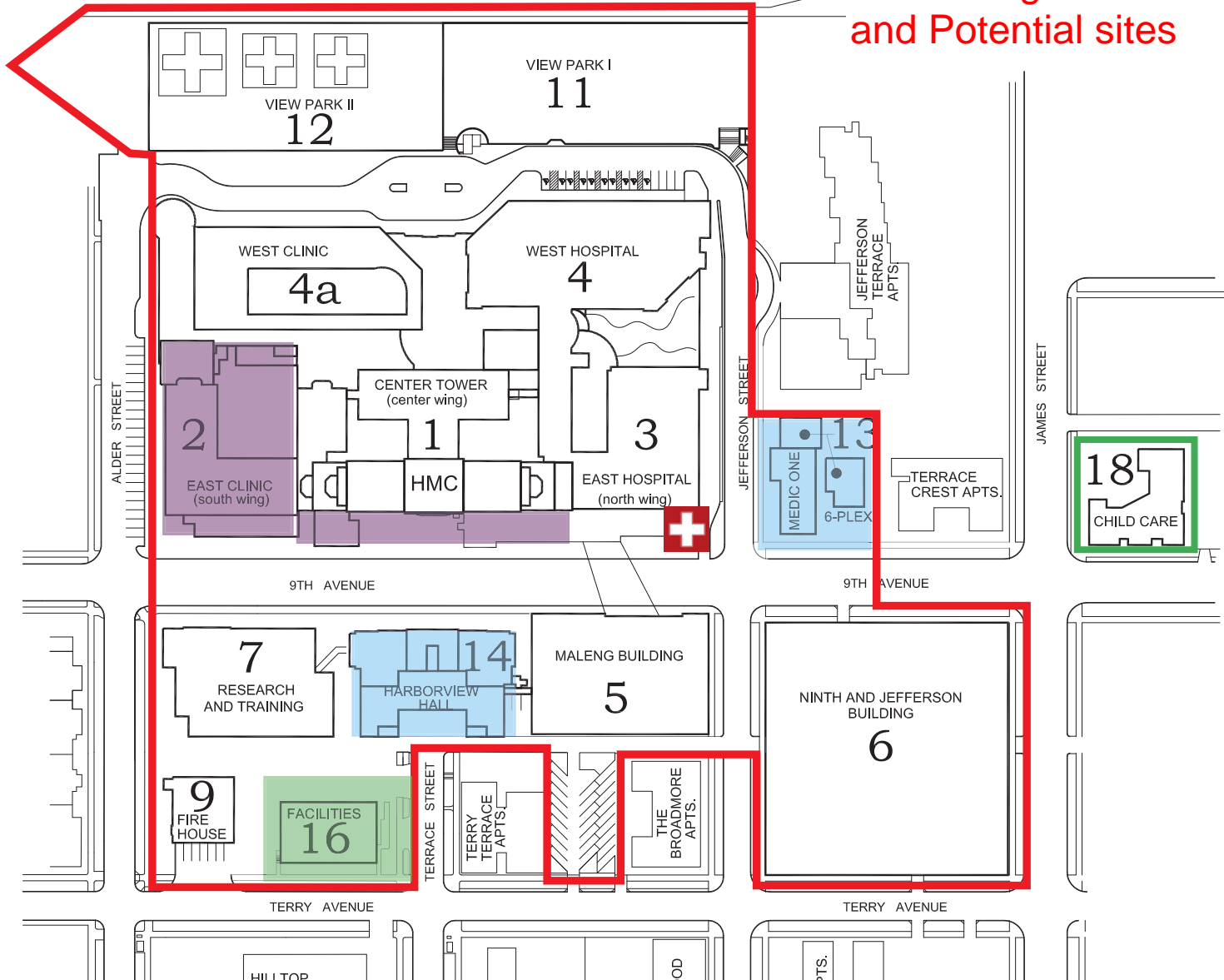
Planned Projects and Potential Projects



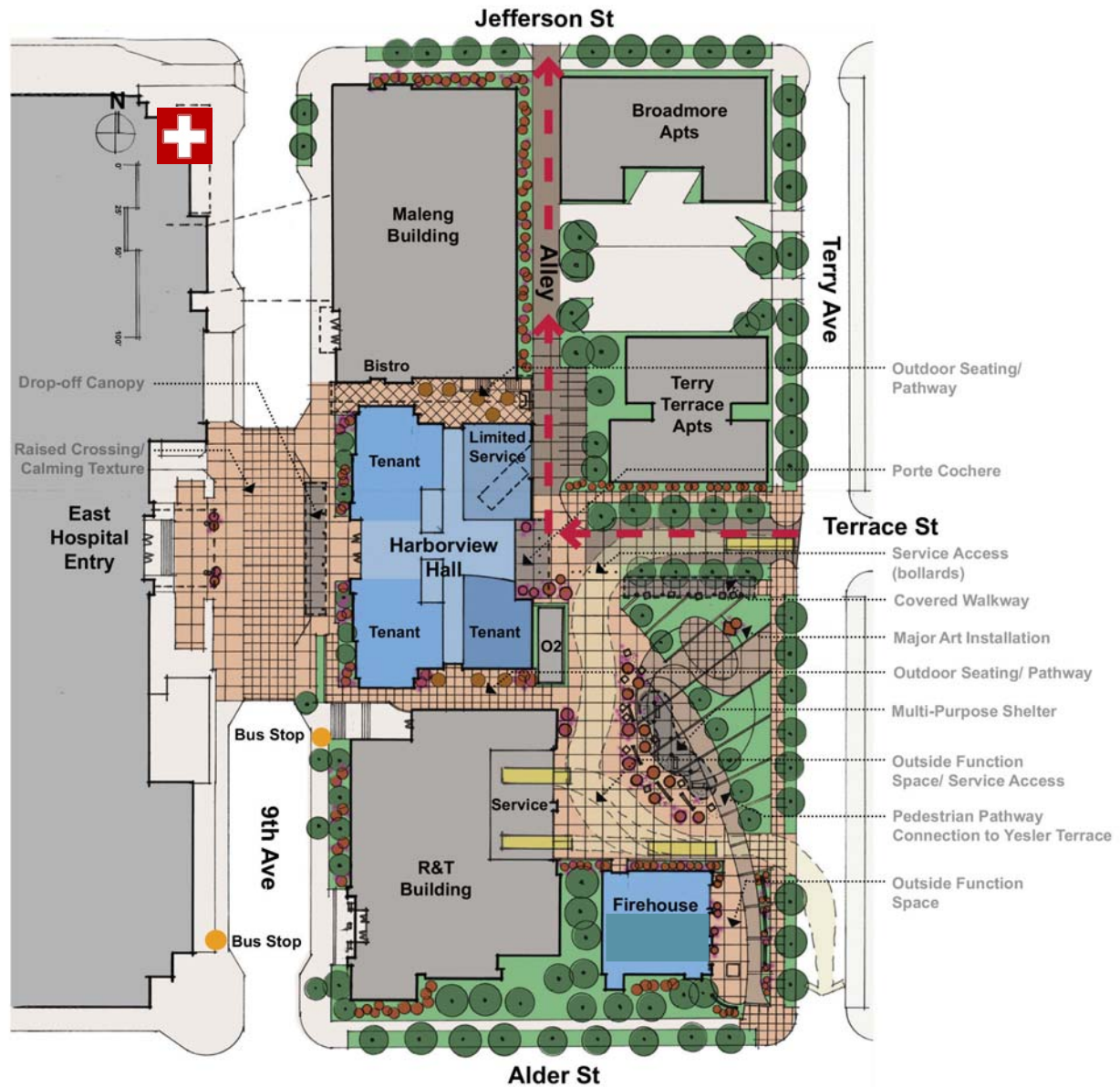

## Current Work –

- Architectural consultant team assessing the Center Tower and East Clinic.
- King County, UW Medicine and Harborview to evaluate assessment results and then begin planning for a potential 2018 voter approved measure.
