

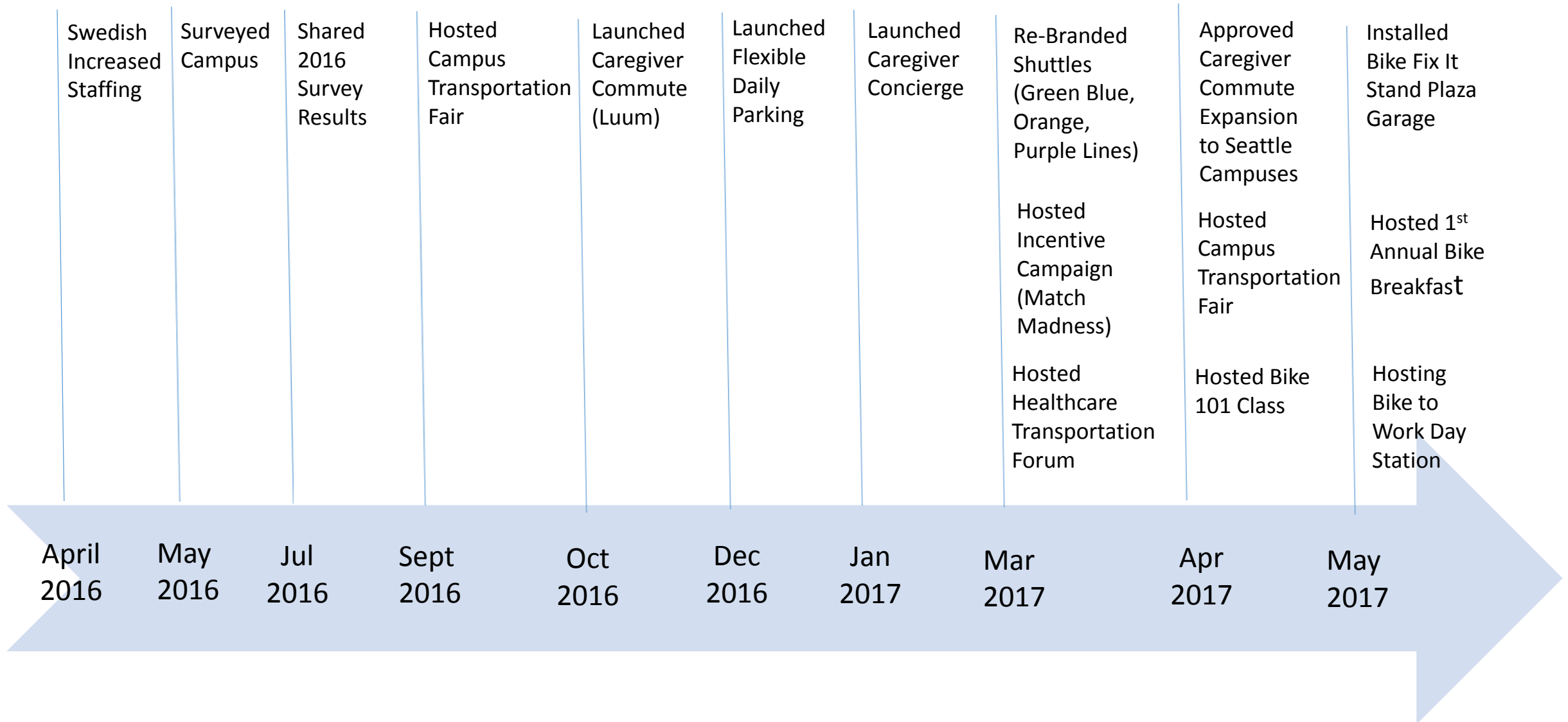

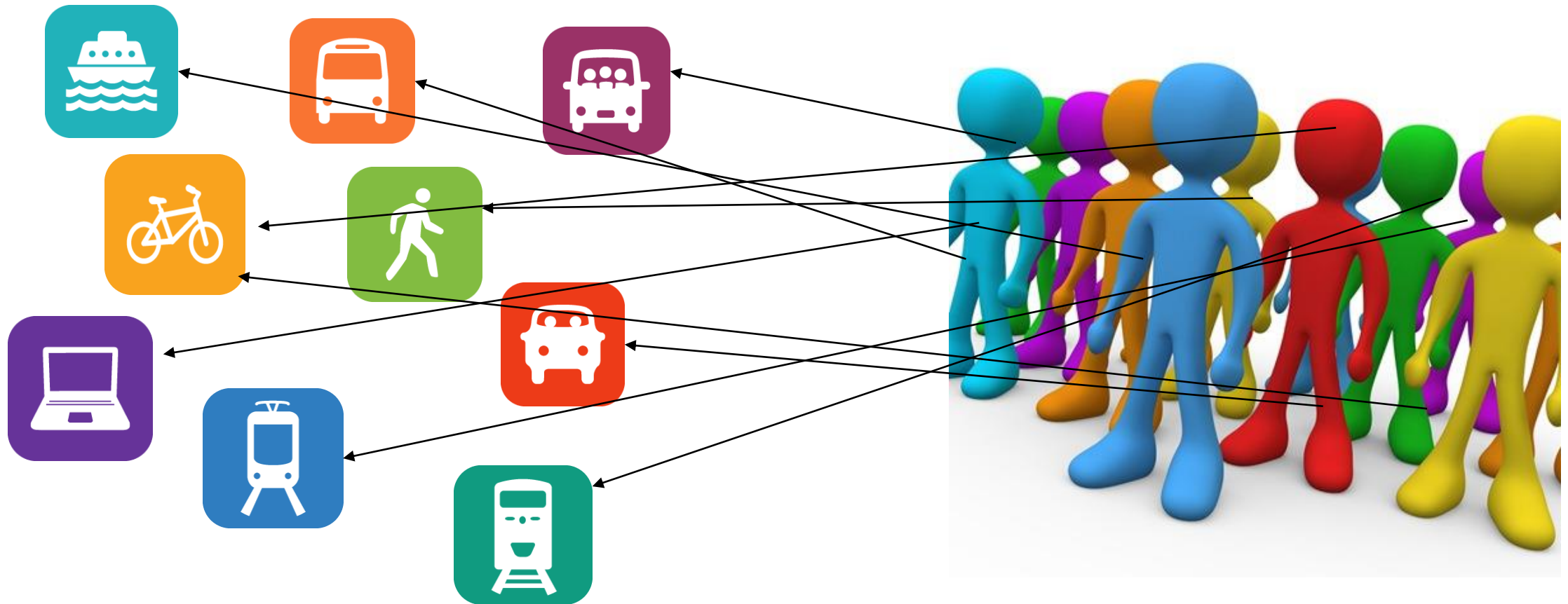

MASTER PLAN REVIEW	
1	Five years after adoption of the Master Plan and every 5 years thereafter, Swedish Medical Center in cooperation with its Standing Advisory Committee (SAC) shall hold a public meeting to review its annual report...
SCHEMATIC AND DESIGN REVIEW	
2	The SAC will review and comment during the schematic and design stage of all proposed and potential projects intended for submission of applications to the City as follows: ...
TRANSPORTATION, LOADING AND TRANSIT	
3	TMP Goal Prior to First Issuance of Building Permits. The goal for the TMP in the Master Plan will be to achieve...
4	Application of TMP Goal. The TMP goal will apply to everyone who works within the Swedish-Cherry Hill MIO at least 20 hours/week and arrives for work between 6:00 AM and 9:AM.

12	Concept Streetscape Design Plan for 18th Avenue. MIMP Conditions Overview & Progress

- Conditions range from design requirements, to traffic management considerations, to MIMP text amendments, to energy and emissions standards
- **Some** Conditions require SAC review and comment
- Design & Development Team is maintaining a spreadsheet to **track progress**
- Progress will be shared with SAC at appropriate intervals

Condition 12: Streetscape Design

12. Concept Streetscape Design Plan for 18th Avenue.

Condition 12: Streetscape Design

Key Features of Condition 12

Prior to submittal of the first Master Use Permit:

- Submit to SDOT for review and approval, a concept streetscape design plan for both sides of 18th Avenue between East Cherry and East Jefferson
- Concurrently, submit draft to the SAC for its review and comment

The concept design plan must:

- Be consistent with the Seattle Right-of-Way Improvements Manual
- Follow SDOT & Seattle Greenway standards *if* 18th Avenue is designated as a Greenway
- Include wayfinding for pedestrians and bicyclists, pedestrian-scale lighting and landscaping along frontages.
- Elements & design requirements may be modified by SDOT

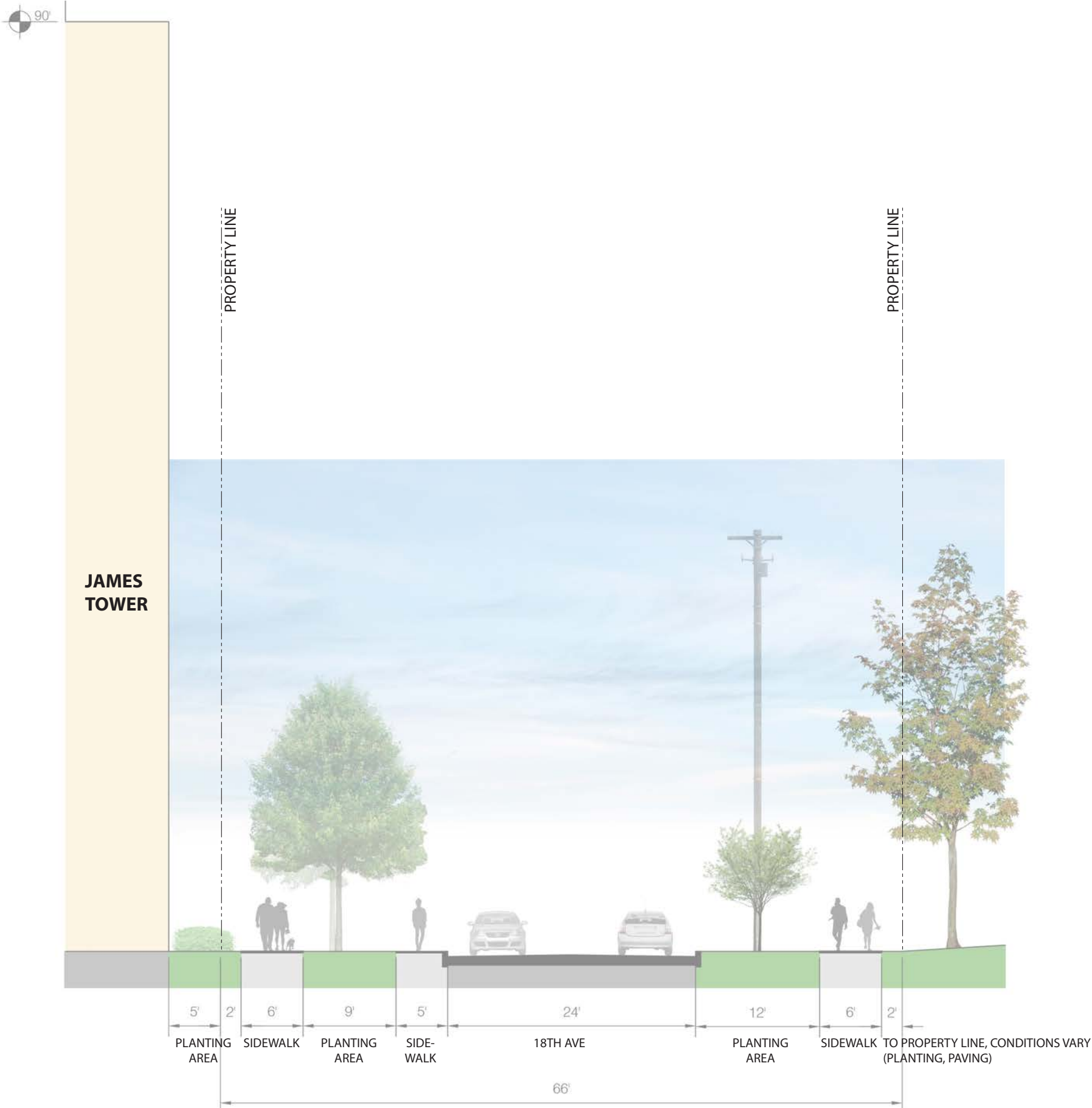
18TH AVE STREETScape - EXISTING



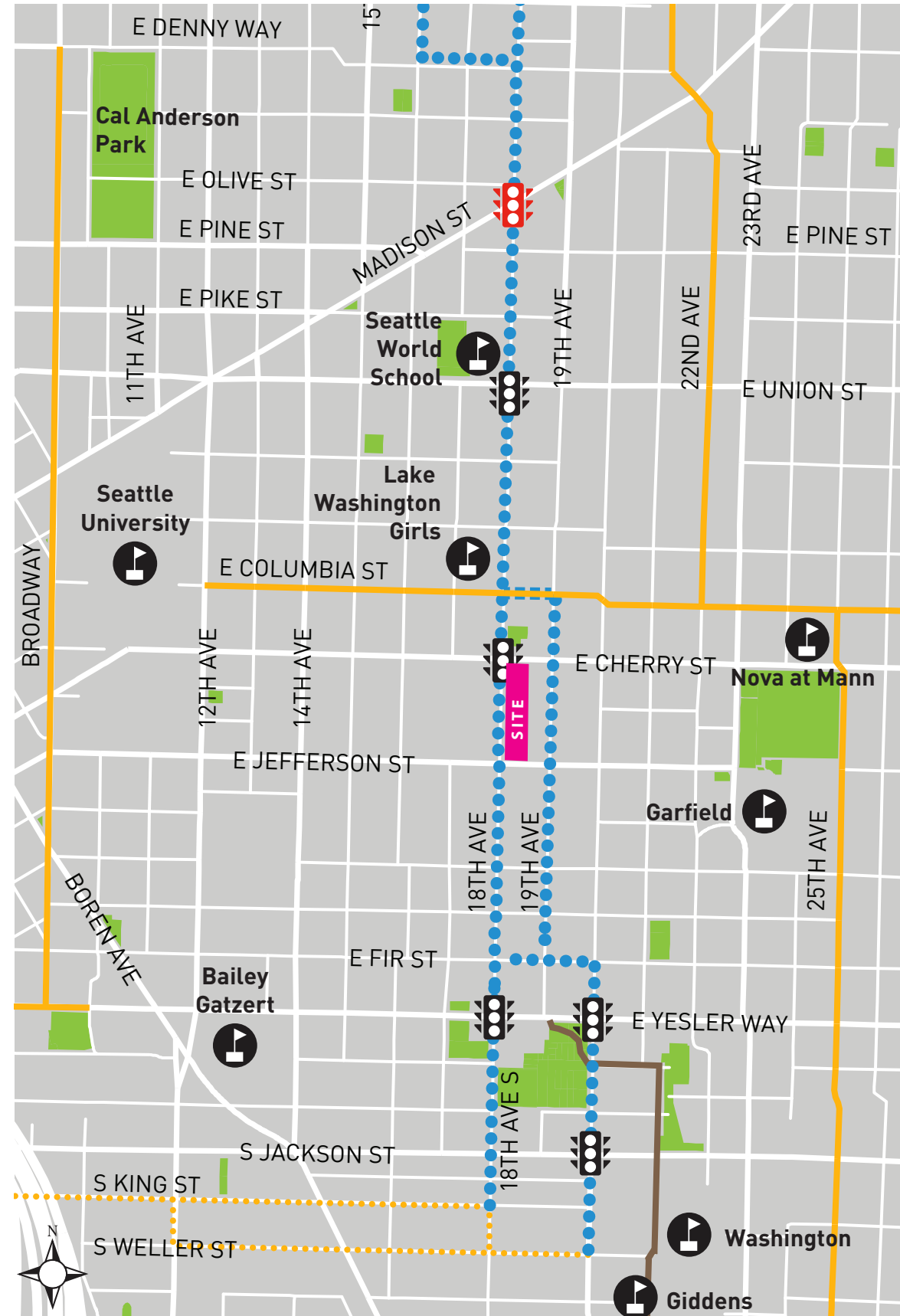

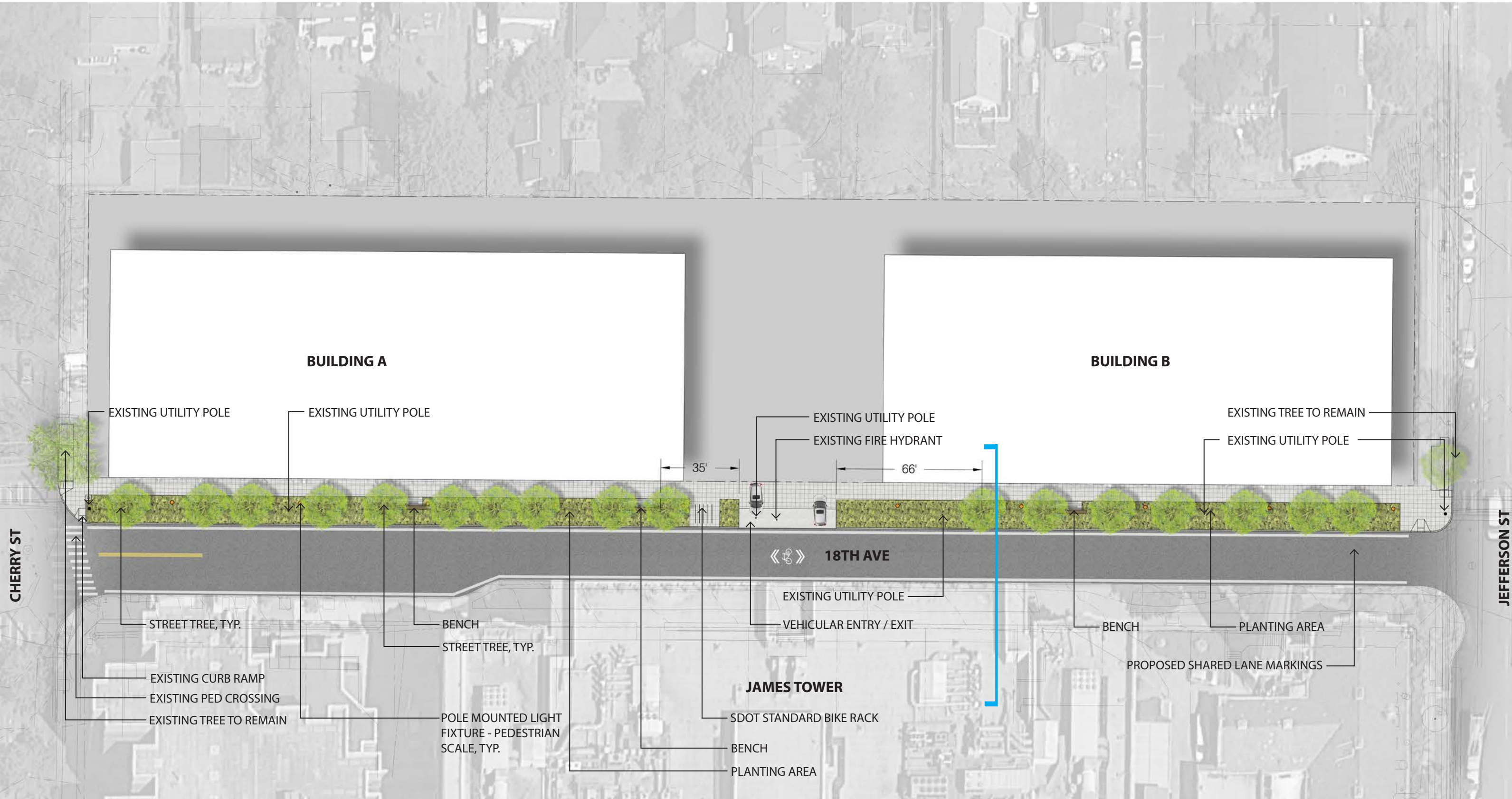

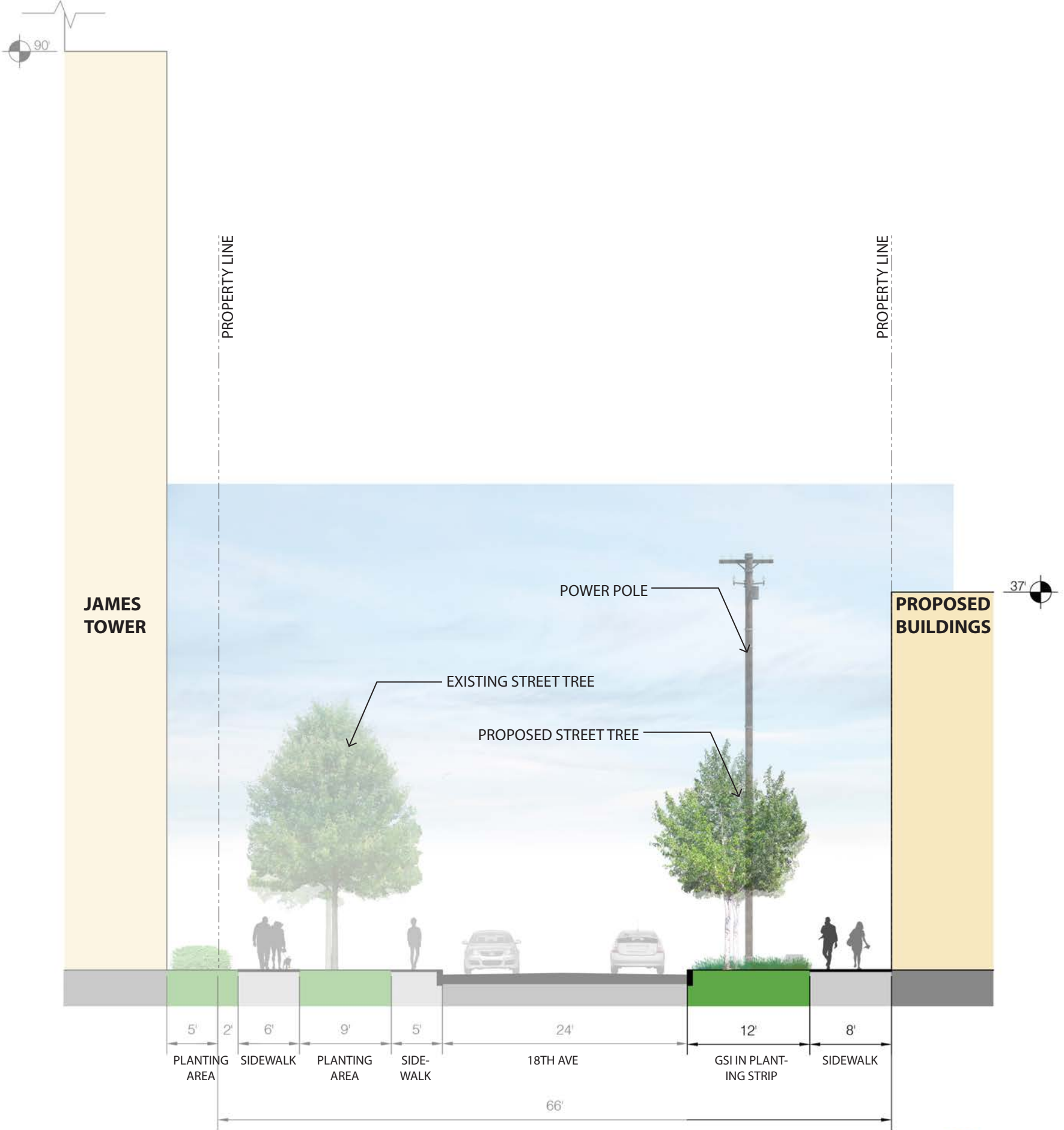

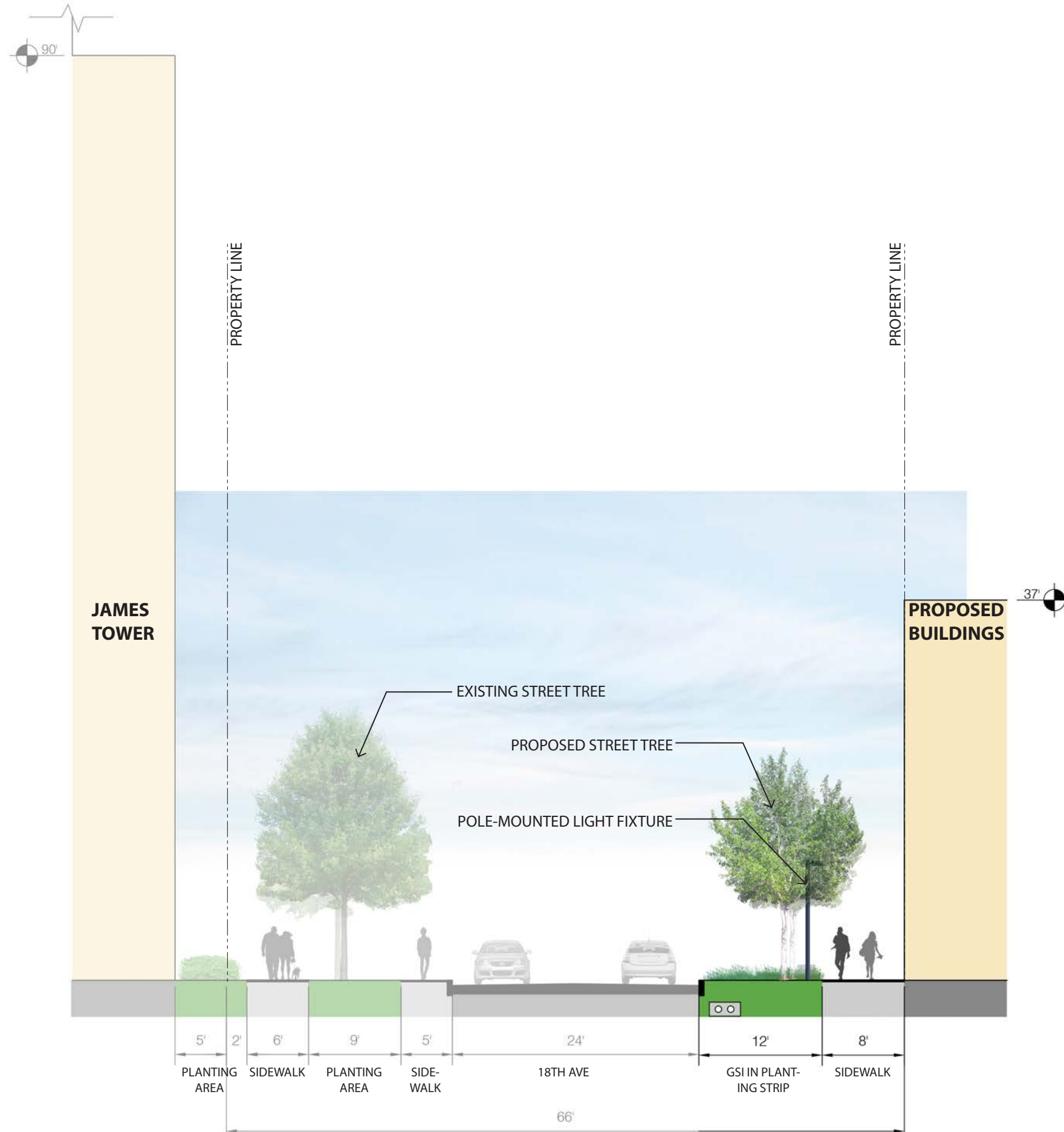
