INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

In the early hours of the morning, an unknown bicycle officer, allegedly hit a pedestrian as they rode past the pedestrian.

COMPLAINT

The complainant, the pedestrian, alleged that an unknown employee rode up behind her on a bicycle, hitting her with the bicycle, worsening a previous injury.

INVESTIGATION

The OPA investigation included the following actions:

1. Review the complaint email
2. Search for and review of all relevant records and other evidence
3. Interviews of SPD employees

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

A review of the available information provided by the complainant and the investigator could not identify any viable investigative leads on which to proceed further. The complainant only provided an email address and OPA was unable to re-contact the complainant. If additional information were developed, OPA would investigate further.

FINDINGS
