### Week in Review

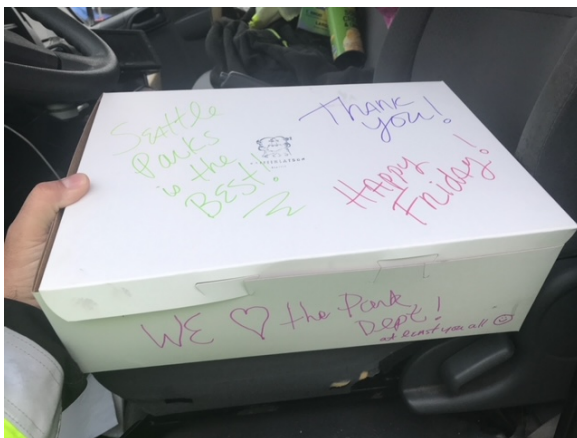
This week community clean team focused on two large emphasis areas in addition to the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. The two emphasis areas included: Oxbow Park and Denny Park. 60 additional Clean Cities sites were also completed. The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Crews.

#### **By the Numbers:**

- 1,195 needles collected
- 600 lbs. of debris removed during the jamboree clean at Denny Park
- 87,530 lbs. trash collected via Community Clean Teams
- 21 blocks of litter pickup by SDOT
- 1 curb mile of street swept
- 446 tents counted onsite; 0 abandoned tents removed

## Clean Cities Emphasis Areas

- Oxbow Park- 3/9, this small postage stamp sized park packs a big punch with the giant Hat and Boots being a tourist draw. SE crew weeded shrub beds, cut back some shrubs, removed English Ivy and edged the park. The gravel pathway and bunker has been redefined. 1 tent and 1 needle, no debris.
