look like at Green Lake. Schacht Aslani Architects completed a study of the existing building and programming needs in 2017. They will present this background work as the basis for moving forward. The project is currently funded through the first phase of design with a \$100,000 grant from the Seattle Department of Neighborhoods. The Rowing Advisory Council is actively seeking additional funding for the subsequent design phases and construction from the Seattle Park District Major Projects Challenge Fund, State grants and private fundraising.

The goal of this project is to make improvements to the facility to better serve the public.
