## **4. Relentless Follow-up and Assessment**

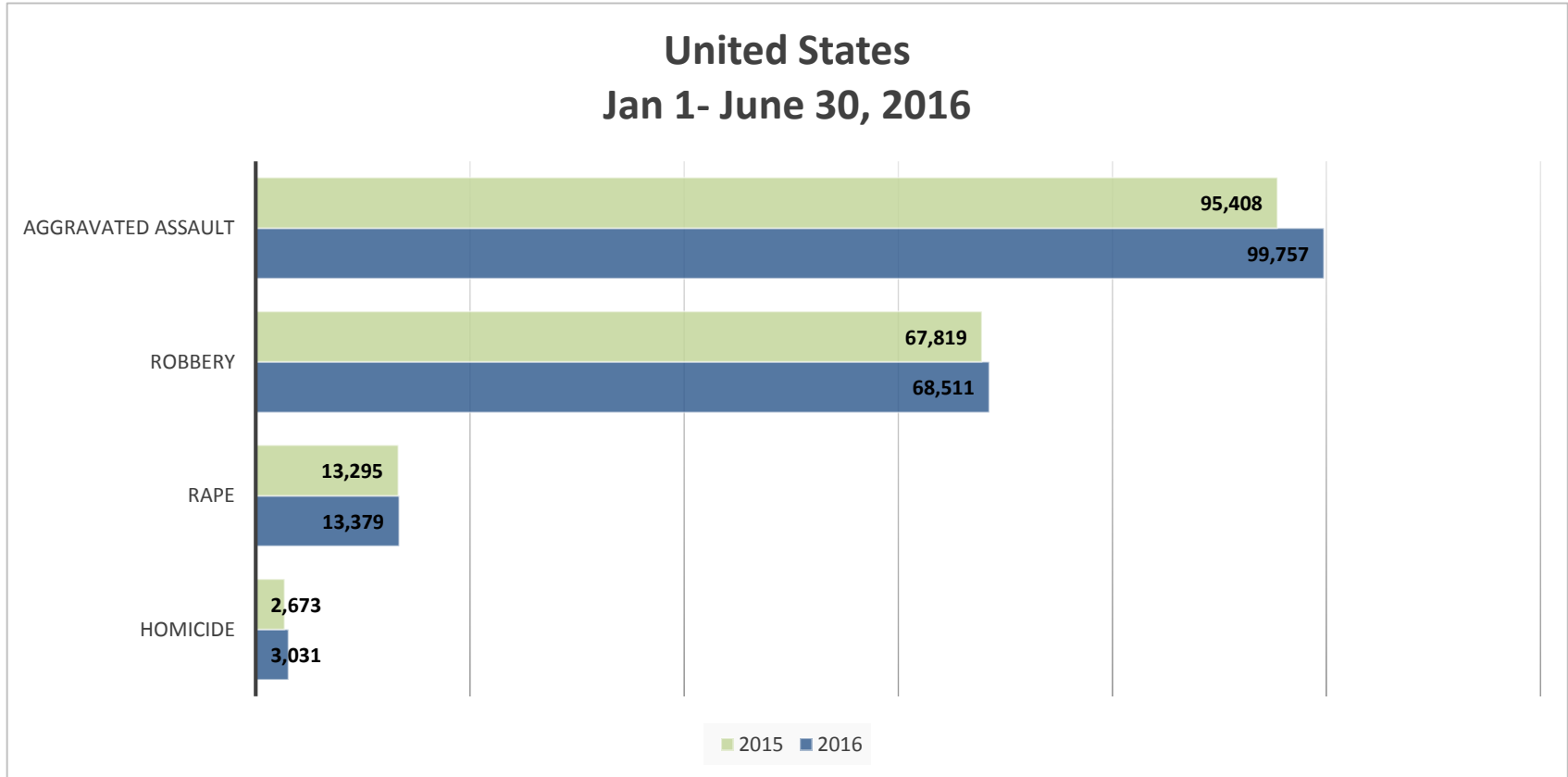

# NATIONWIDE CRIME TRENDS

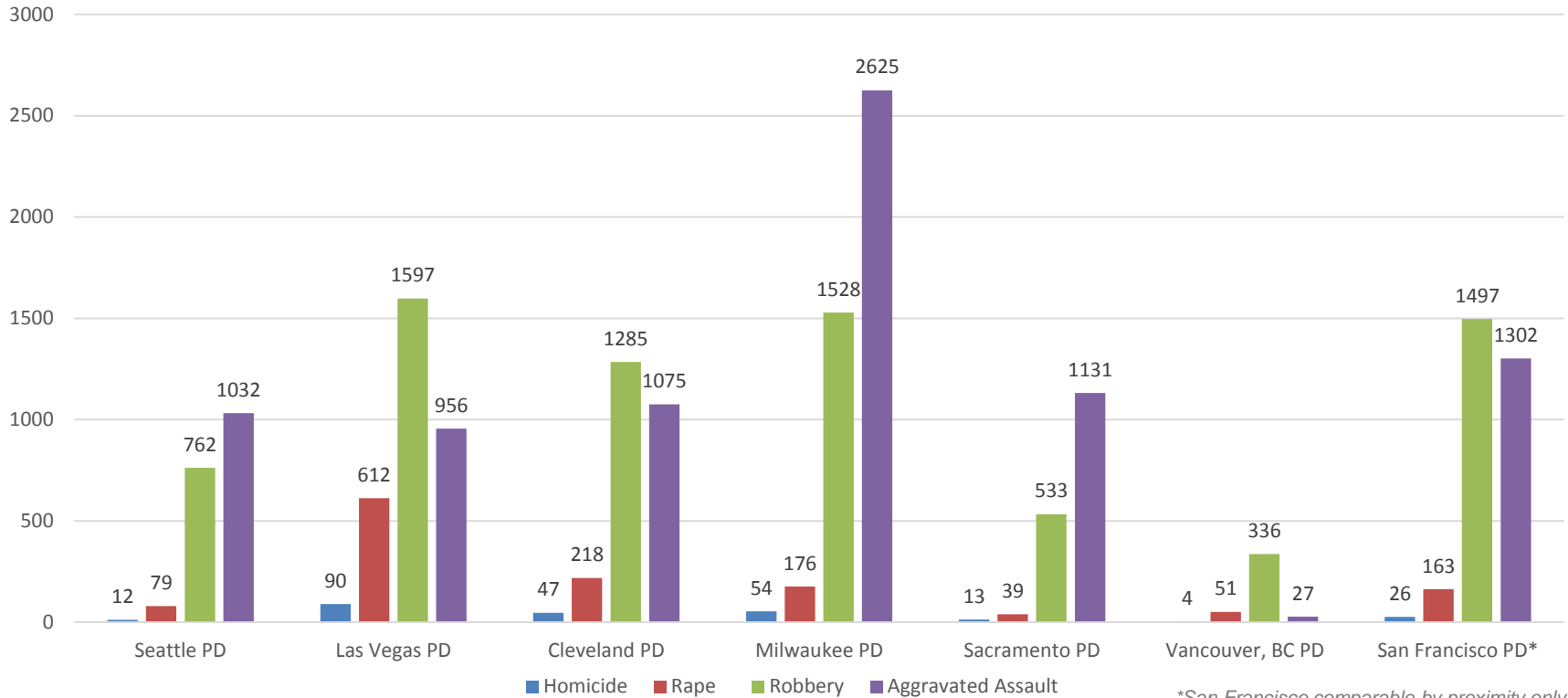

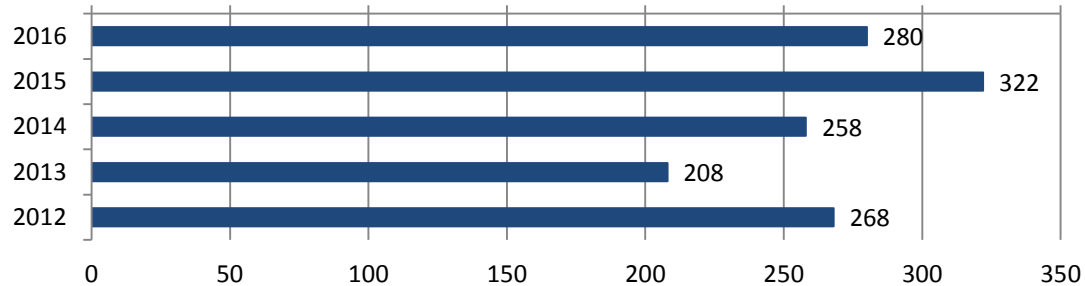

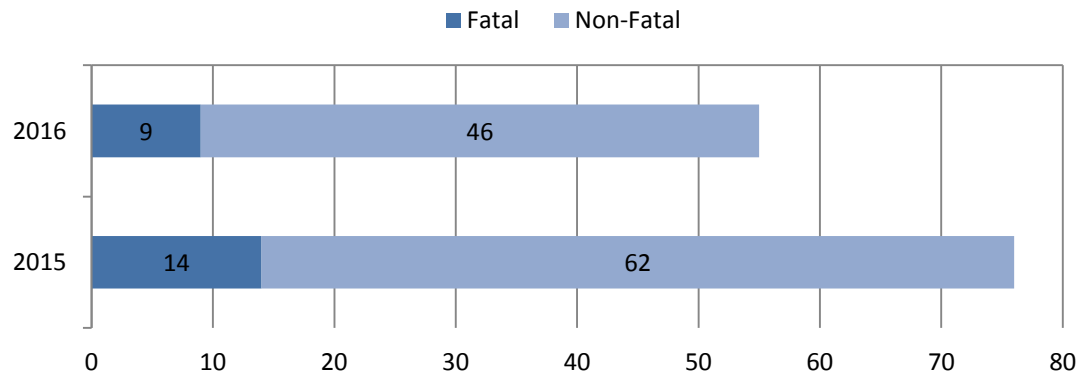

January 1 to October 24 (2015 and 2016)

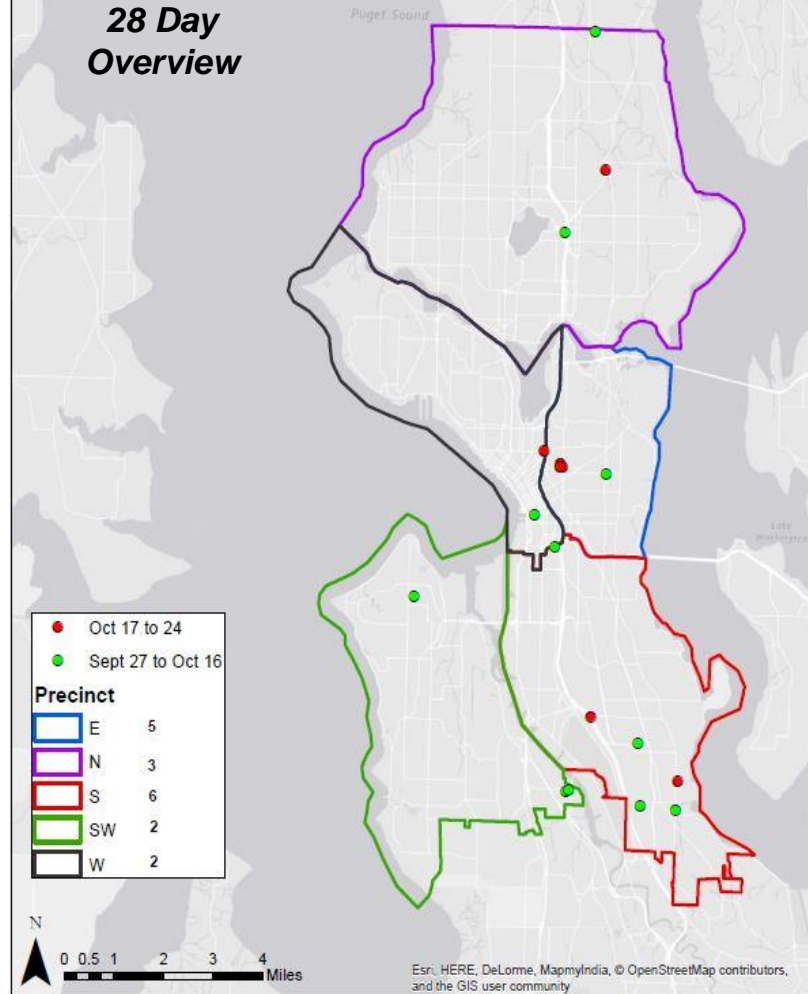

**Target/Victim:** Primarily A/F's between ages 35-75.

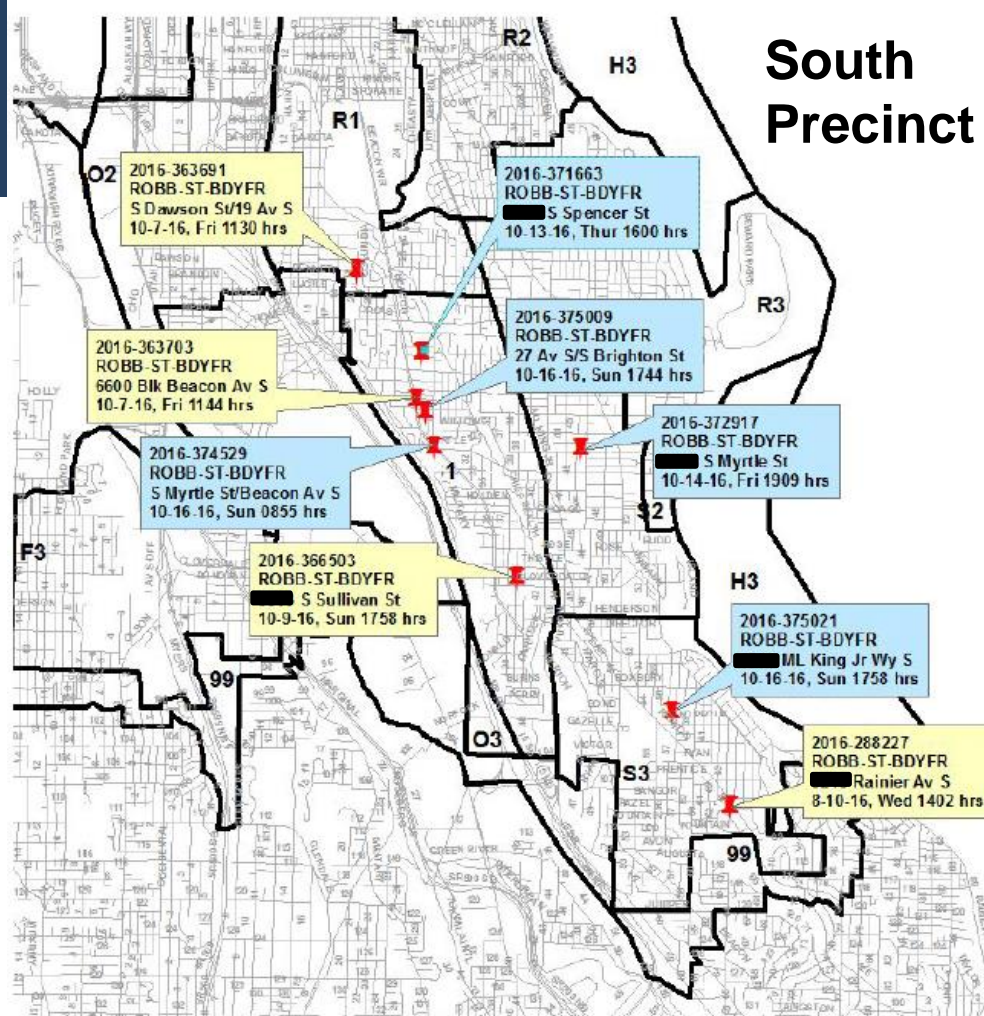
**Victim Actions:** Most were walking from parked cars to residences in close proximity.
