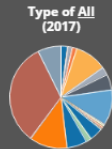
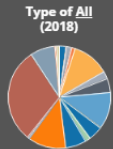

### Investigation Details

#### Homicide

In 2018, the 32 reported homicide incidents resulted in 32 victims. In 2017, 28 homicide incidents resulted in 29 victims (one double homicide). Homicide detectives have investigated incidents that involved homeless victims, nightlife, and domestic violence. Within 2018's 32 homicides, 12 incidents involved homeless individuals (compared to 2 incidents in 2017), 5 that originated from domestic violence (even with 5 in 2017) and 5 that shared a nexus with nightlife activity (up from 3 in 2017).

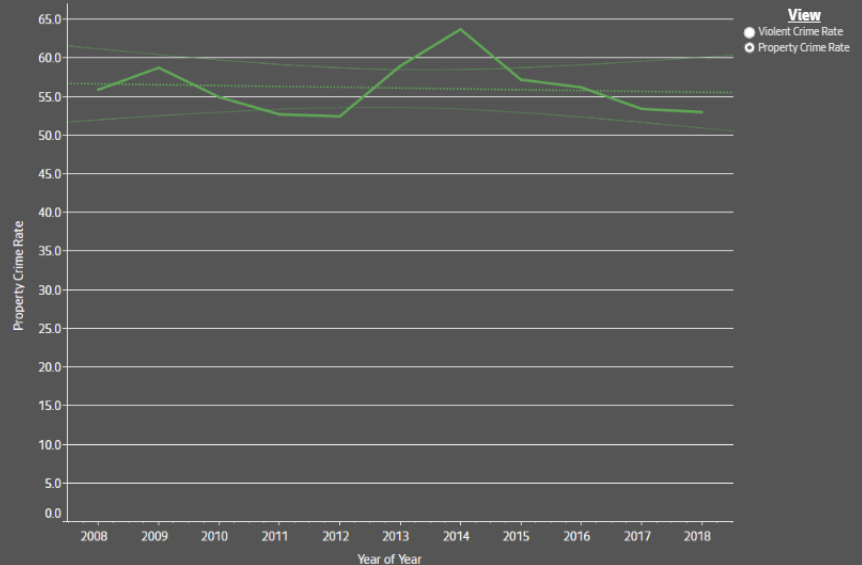

### Citywide Historical Crime Rates

Crime rates below are calculated based upon the Washington Office of Financial Management's population totals for the city of Seattle. Rates confer an advantage over totals because they represent the number of crime incidents relative to population size. While crime rates are not a proxy for understanding how likely any given person is to be a victim of a crime, they allow statements to be made about how much crime takes place within the city's population.

Violent Crime Rate: Calculated per 1,000  
Property Crime Rate: Calculated per 10,000

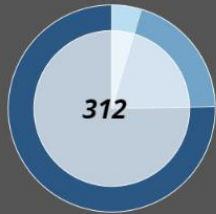
## Citywide Shots Fired and Shooting Events

 \*This report does not count the number of victims and should only be interpreted at the incident-level.\*

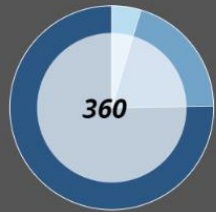

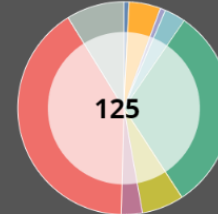
## Citywide Hate Crimes

 \*This report does not count the number of victims and should only be interpreted at the incident-level.\*

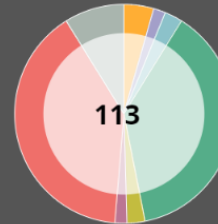

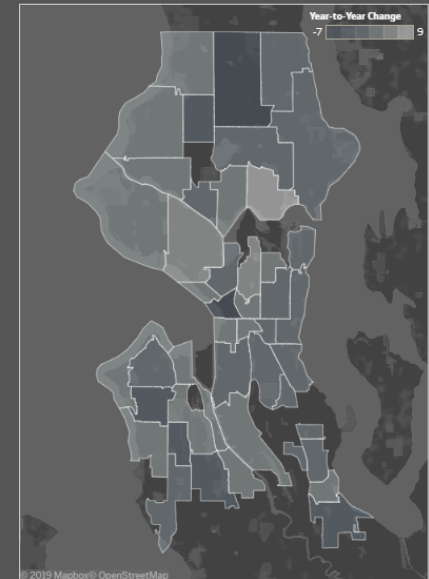

### Year-Over-Year Change (2017 to 2018)



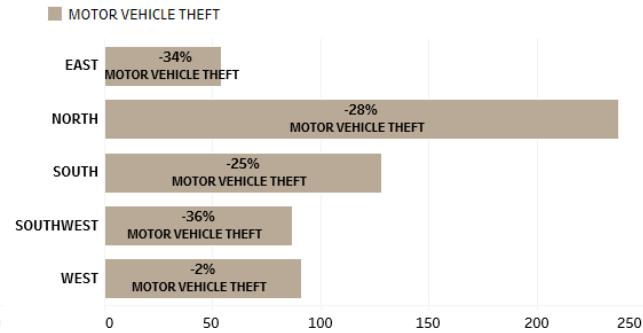
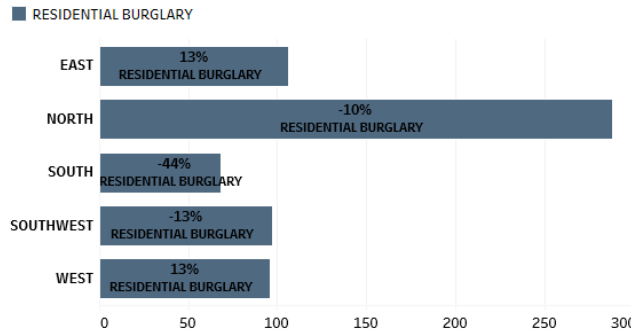
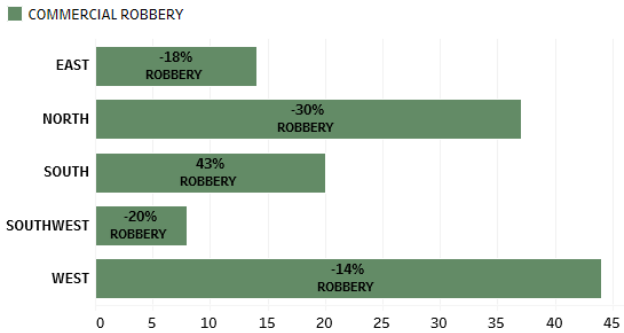
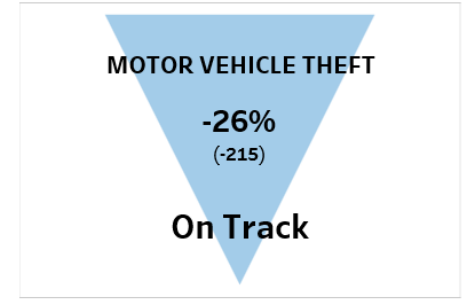
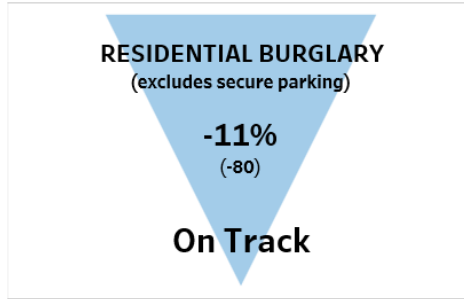
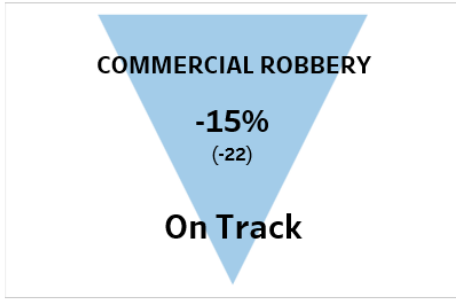

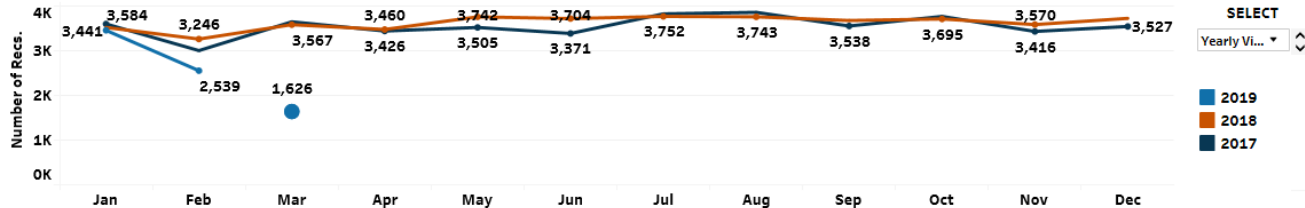
