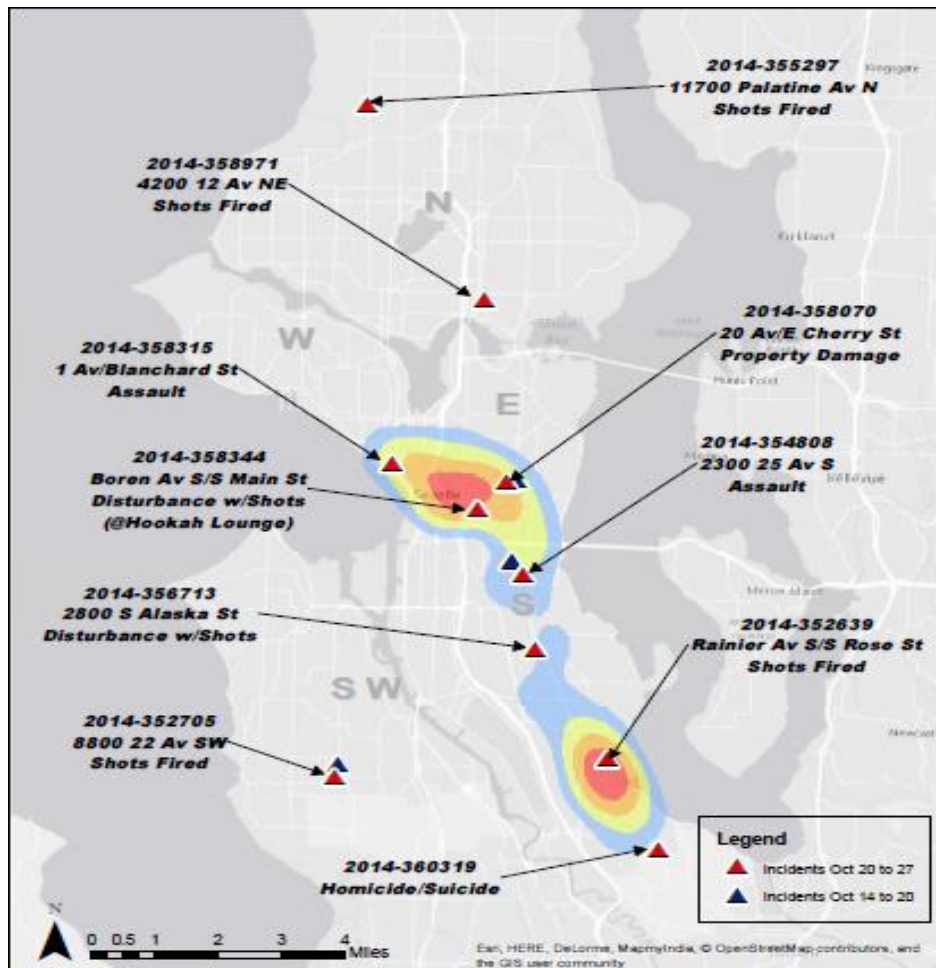

Shots Fired Incidents October 14 – 27, 2014



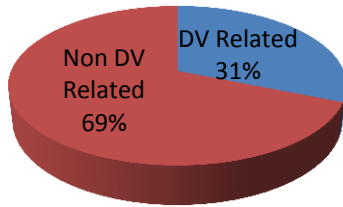

Aggravated Assault January to September 2014

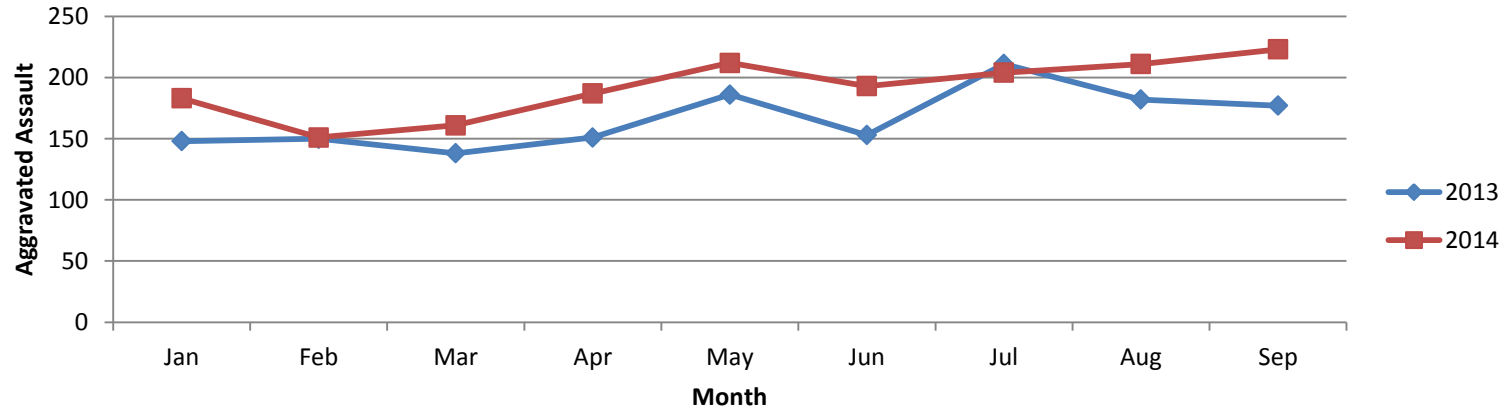

January to September (2014 compared to 2013)

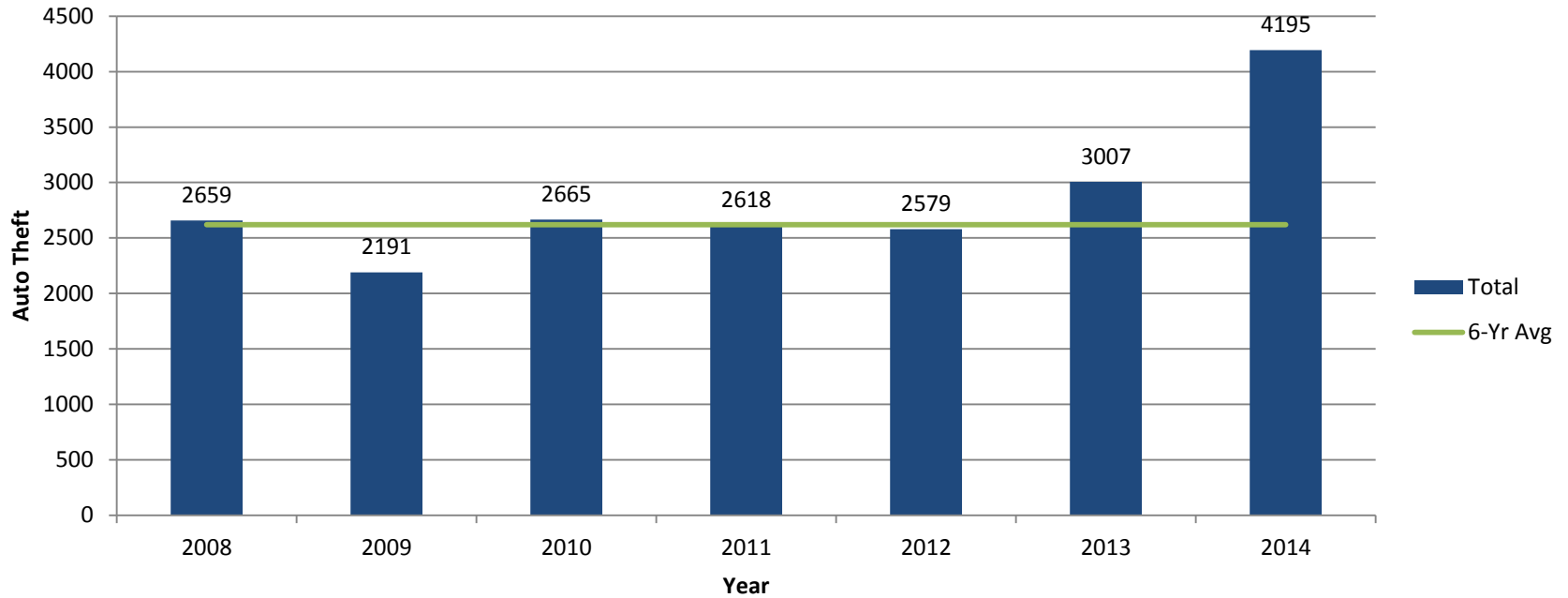
- 15% Increase in Aggravated Assault from 2013

Aggravated Assault for the City of Seattle January to September (2013 and 2014)

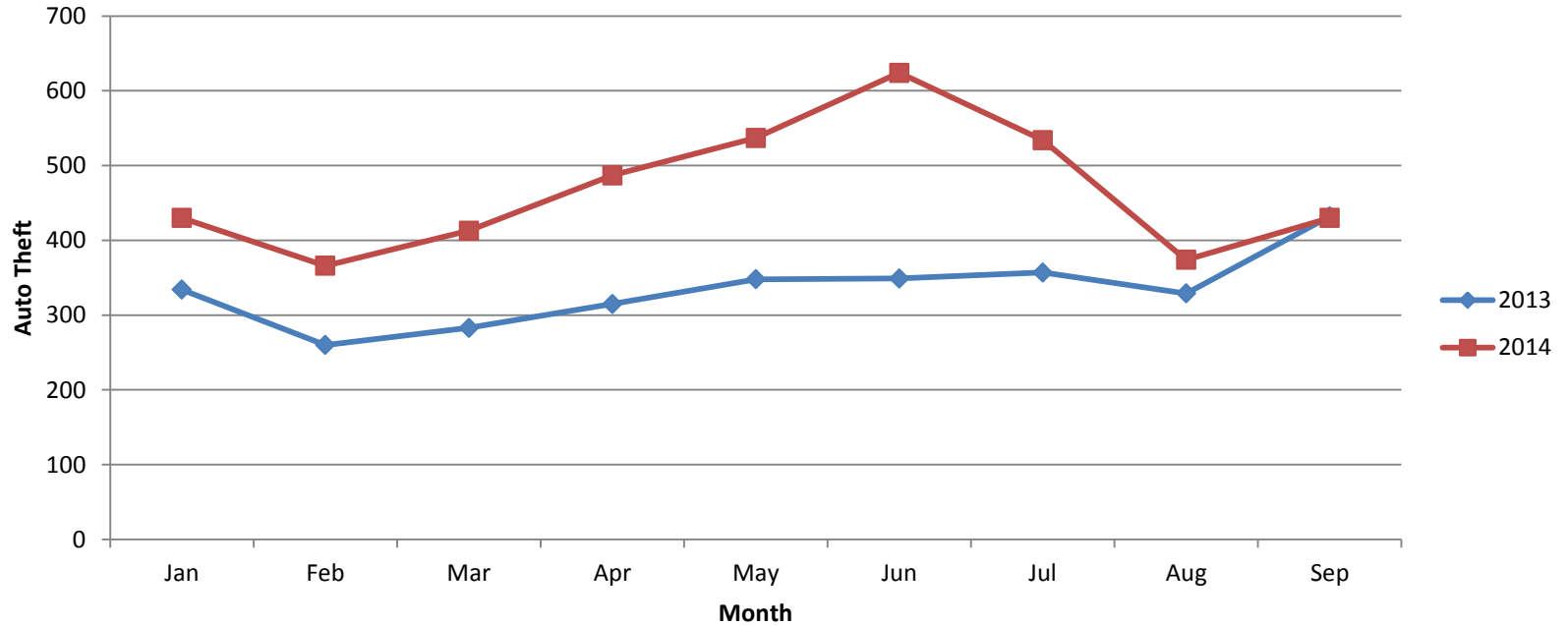


Auto Theft for the City of Seattle

9 Month Overview: January to September 2008-2014

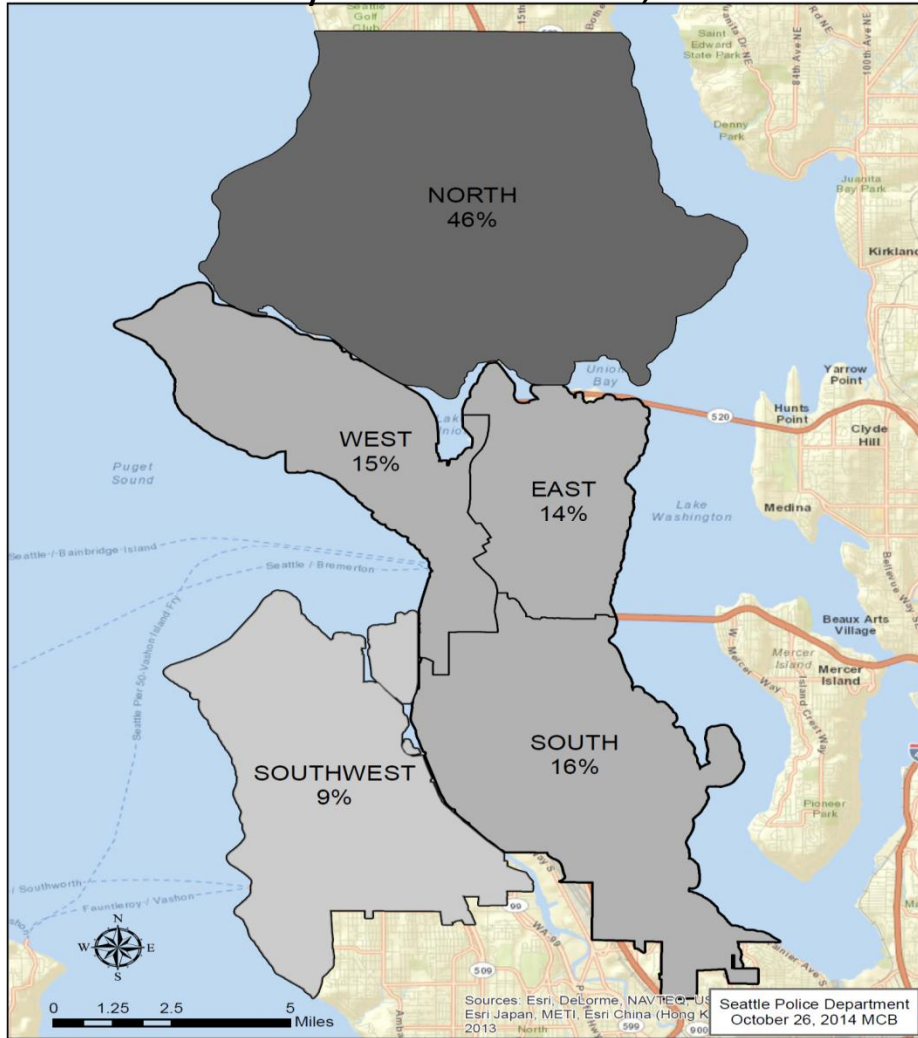


Auto Theft for the City of Seattle 9 Month Overview: January to September 2013 and 2014



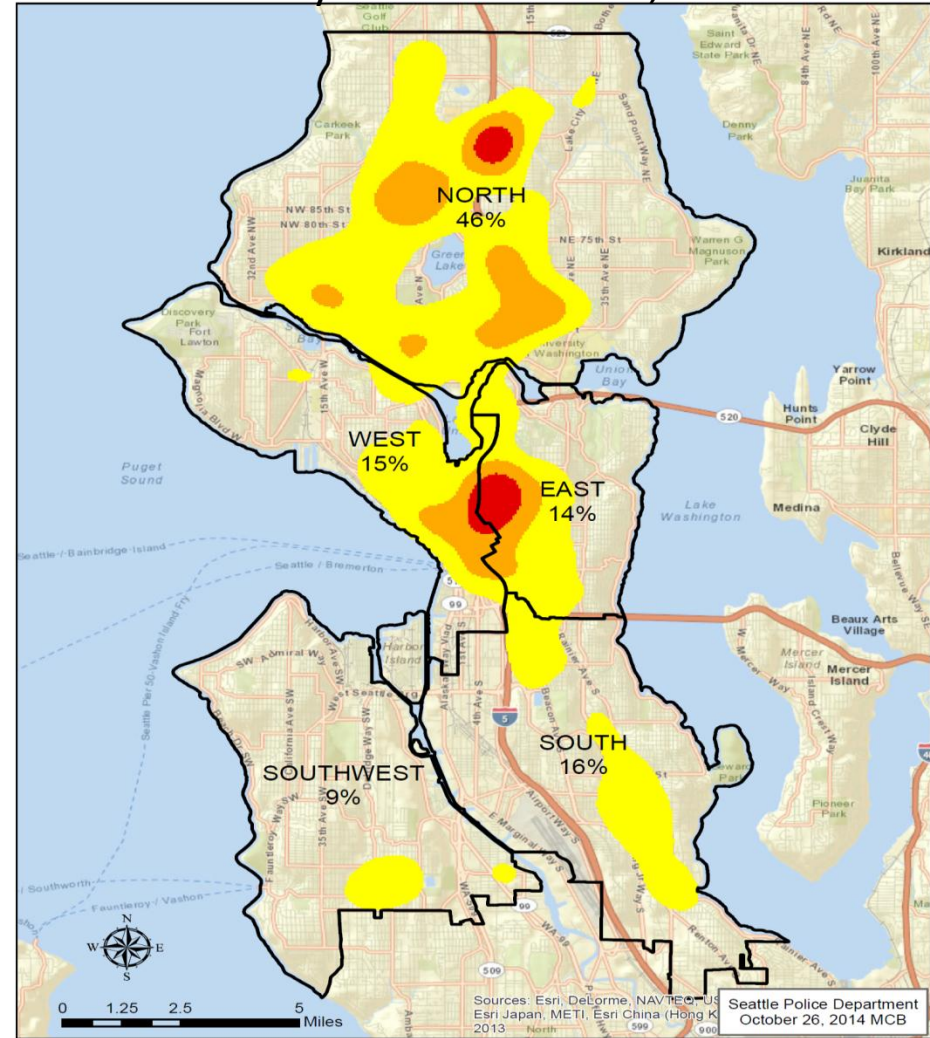
Auto Theft Percentage by Precinct

January 1 to October 25, 2014

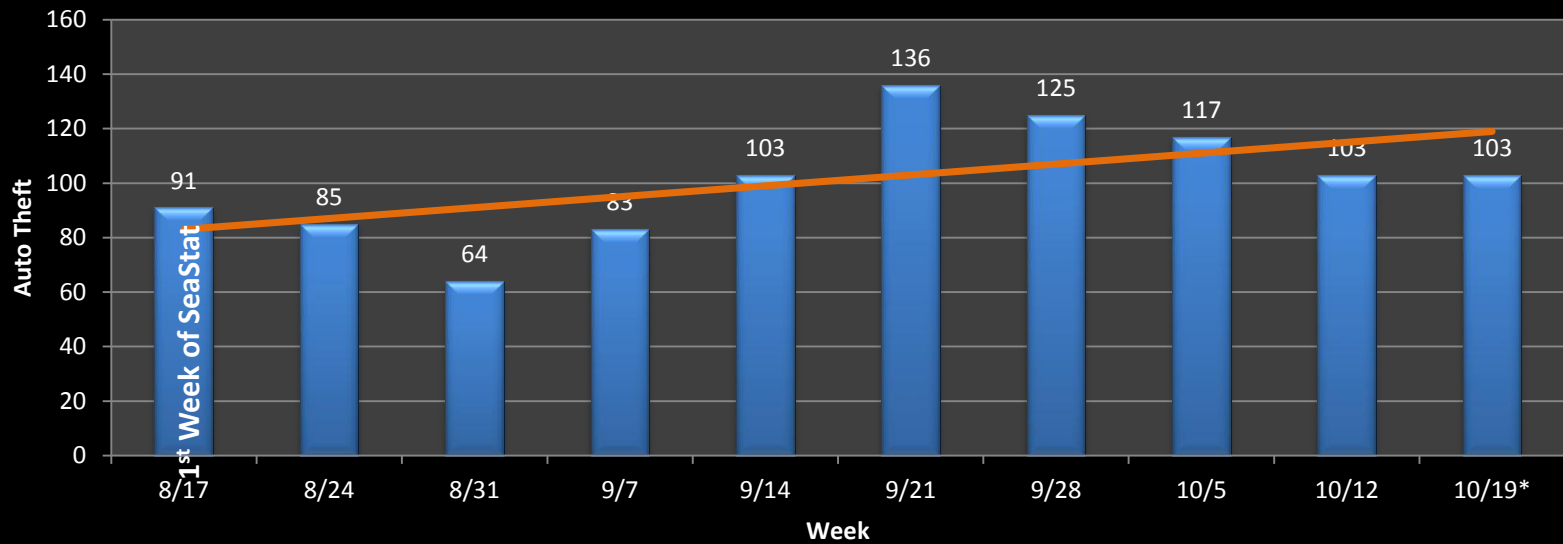


Auto Theft Density by Precinct

January 1 to October 25, 2014

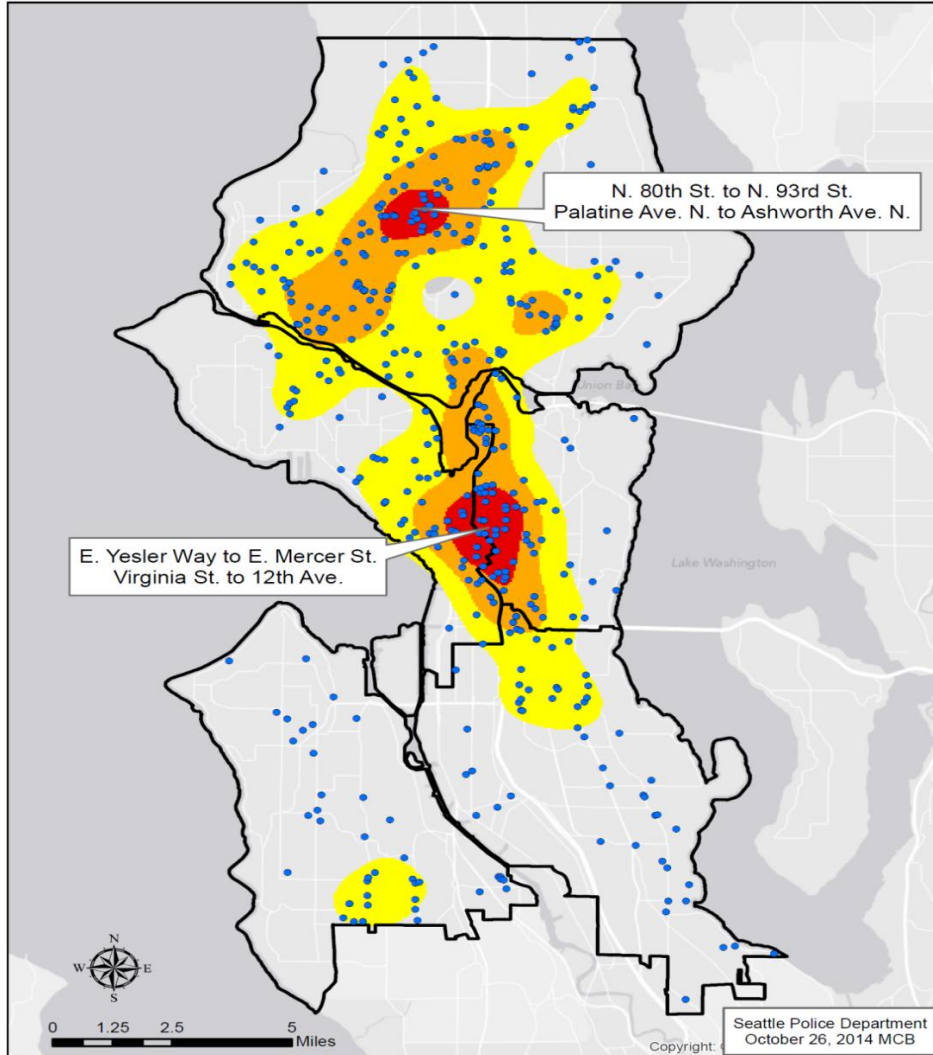


Auto Theft for the City of Seattle by Week 10 Week Overview: August 17 to October 25, 2014

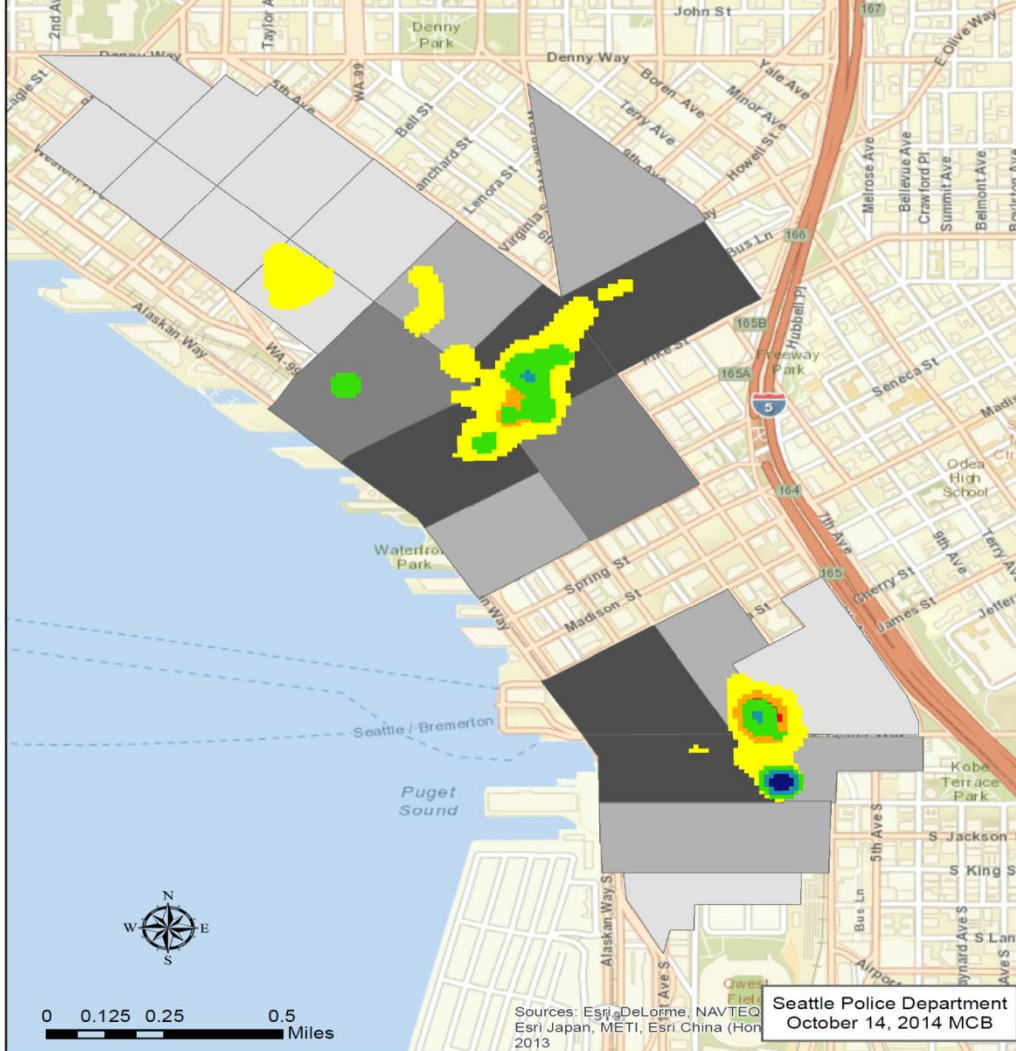

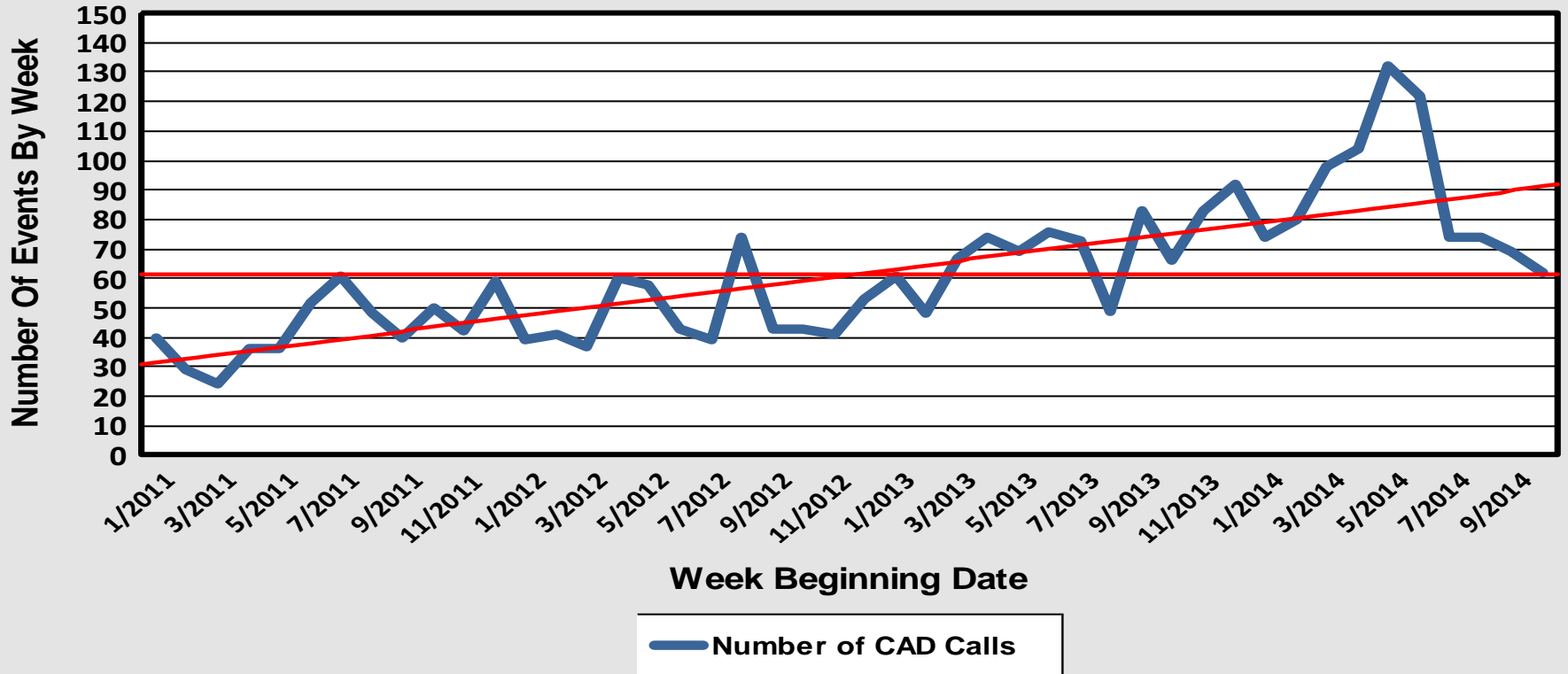

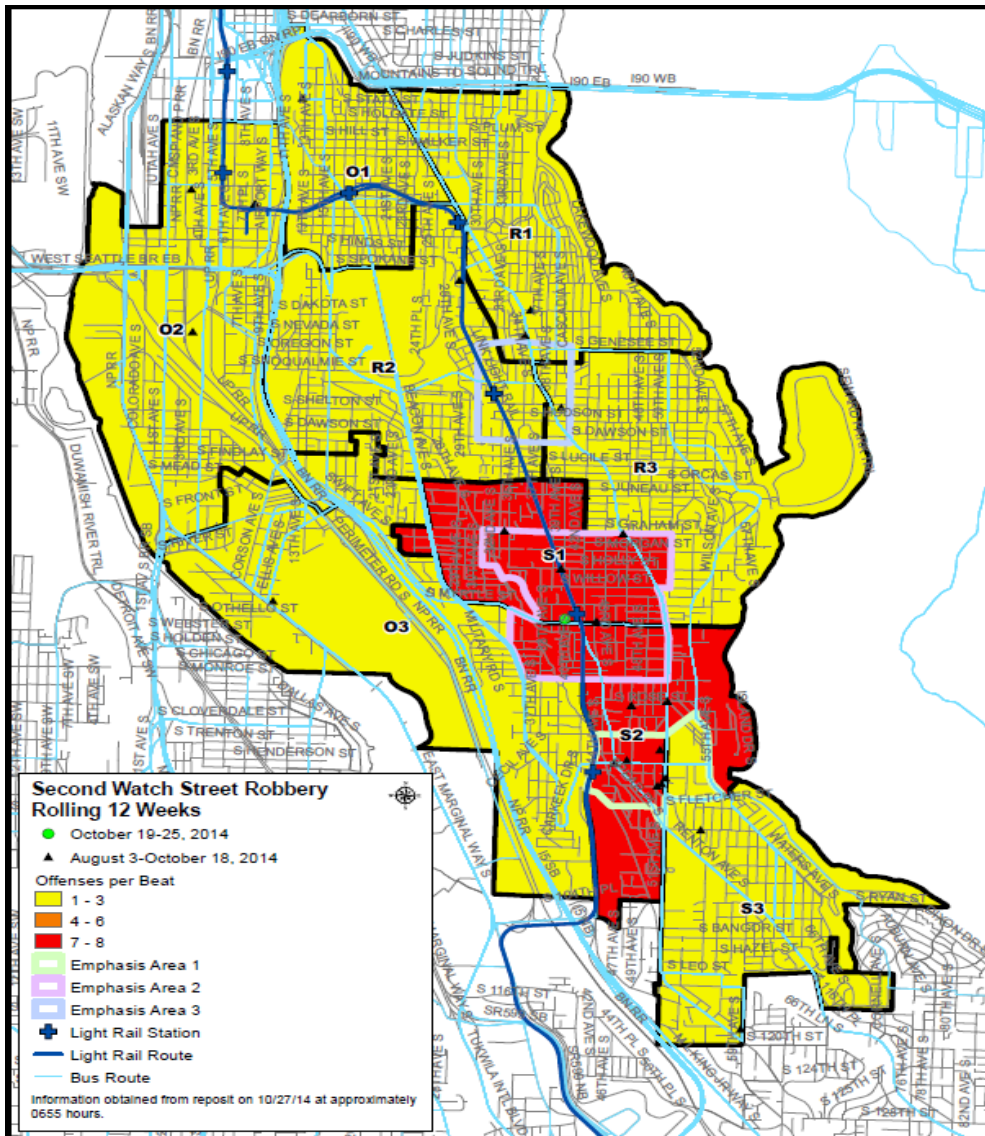

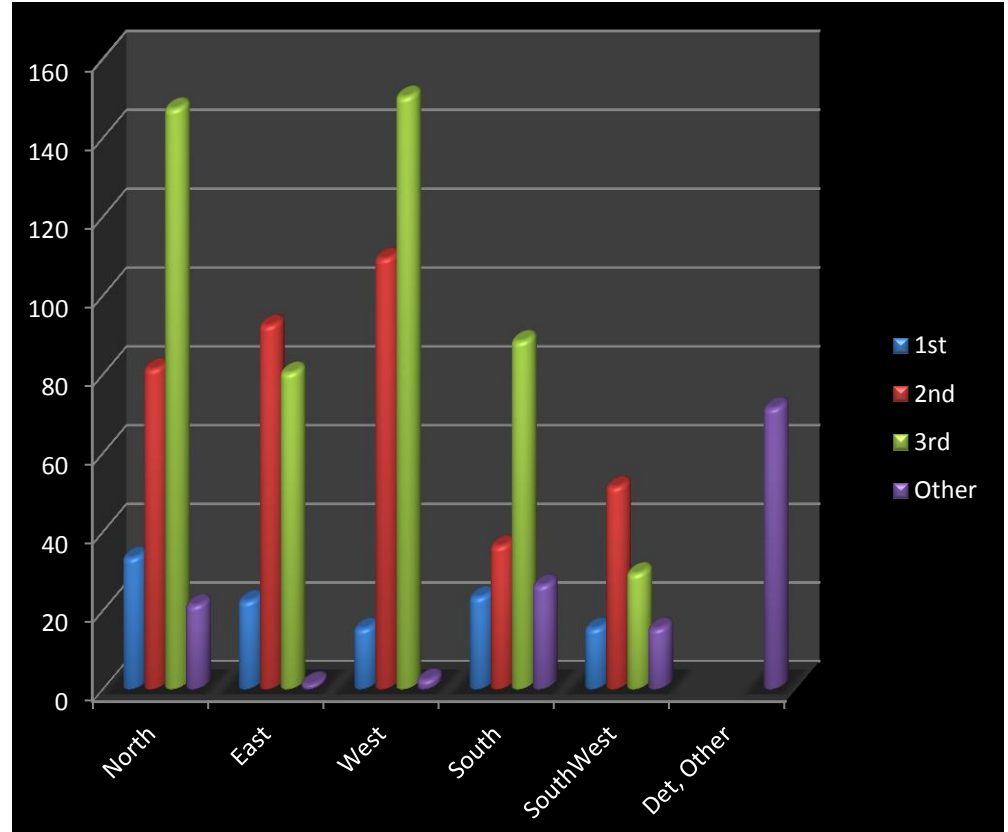

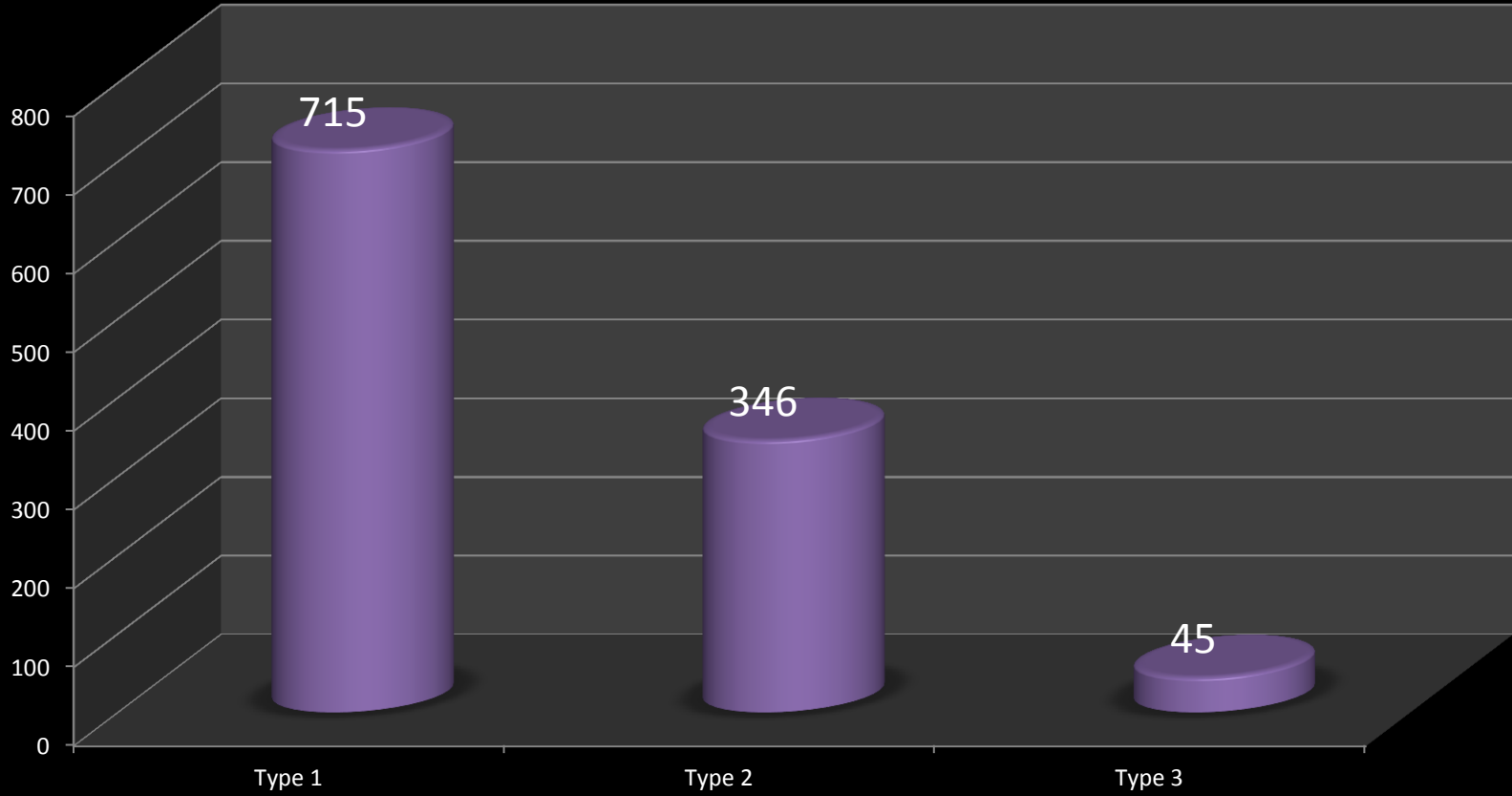

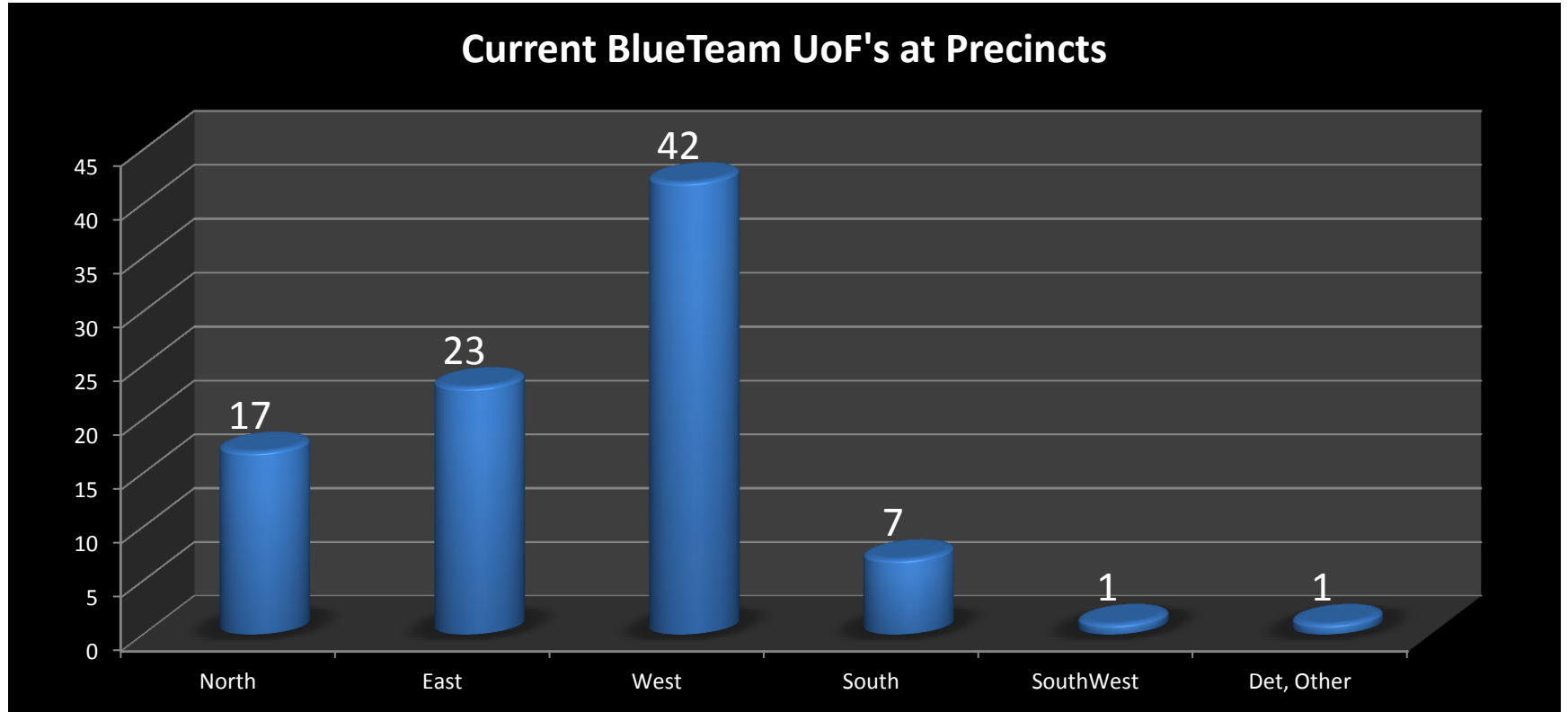
