Aurora Ave N & N 83rd St Mobility Improvements

PROJECT OVERVIEW


As soon as March 30th, construction will begin for the crossing improvements at Aurora Ave N and N 83rd St. These improvements include: a pedestrian traffic signal, realigning the intersection, building extended curbs, and a new crosswalk along the north side of the intersection. This completed work will improve safety for everyone using the intersection of Aurora Ave N, Green Lake Dr N, and N 83rd St.

As part of this project, we will realign N 83rd St so it intersects with Green Lake Dr N only. The lane connecting N 83rd St to Green Lake Dr N will become a one-way southbound, and a right-hand turn toward Aurora Ave N. People driving would need to use Stone Ave N to enter the block between Aurora Ave N and Stone Ave N.

N 83rd St will remain a 2-way street. People walking and biking will be able to access the area as they do today.

BENEFITS

- A safer crossing intersection for Bagley Elementary students and families
- Connects Green Lake Drive N to the North Seattle Neighborhood Greenway on 83rd St
- Safer and more predictable crossings for everyone



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Sidewalk and curb ramp construction
- Typical work hours between 7 AM and 3:30 PM Monday through Friday
- Traffic revisions
- Temporary parking restrictions
- Temporary pedestrian and bike detours around the work zone and staging area
- Access to businesses and home will be maintained at all times
- Typical construction noise, dust, and vibrations

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE AND IMPACTS

Construction begins on the northwest corner of Aurora Ave N and N 83rd St and then will move to the east side of the intersection after the west side is completed. Work will occur Monday to Friday, 7 AM to 3:30 PM. Construction is expected to last about 9-10 weeks and is weather dependent.
