## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

We're working on a transportation safety and mobility project in the Interbay and Magnolia communities to better connect major trails. We're proposing a family-friendly connection for people traveling between the Ship Canal Trail, Elliot Bay Trail, and the Ballard Locks.

Our concept for this project includes redesigning 20th Ave W, Gilman Ave W, and W Emerson Pl to have protected bike lanes and more intuitive and comfortable intersections that keep people driving and delivering goods moving, while separating people biking and walking.
