NORTHGATE NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY

Neighborhood greenways are safer, calmer residential streets for you, your family, and neighbors.

Neighborhood greenways can include:

- easier crossings of busy streets with crosswalks, flashing beacons, or traffic signals
- speed humps to calm traffic
- stop signs for side streets crossing the neighborhood greenway
- 20 mph speed limit signs
- signs and pavement markings to help people find their way



MOST PROMISING ROUTE

We've been working with community members from Northgate and Maple Leaf since spring 2017 to identify routes for a new neighborhood greenway to be built.

We want to create an intuitive connection for people walking and biking between the Northgate Ped/Bike Bridge, Link light rail station, and neighborhoods to the east.

Our proposed route runs east-west on NE 103rd St, north-south on 12th Ave NE to Maple Leaf Reservoir Park, and links up with Northgate Park via 8th Ave NE and NE 105th St.

Based on community feedback, we're also planning a Phase 2 buildout for the neighborhood greenway pending available funding in the coming years. This route would connect to the Pinehurst neighborhood and Hazel Wolf K-8 School.

Making residential streets safer and calmer for you, your family, neighbors, and customers

The neighborhood greenway will give people walking and biking a calmer route between Northgate and Maple Leaf.

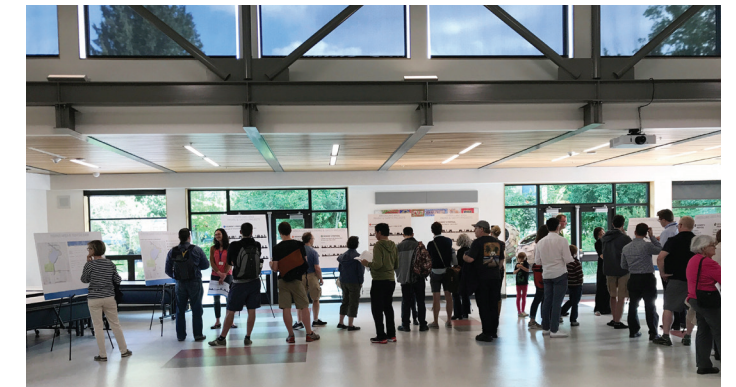
