

# SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL RAINIER VIEW ELEMENTARY

FACT SHEET April 2017

#### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

We are committed to making it safer and easier for kids, families, and neighbors to walk and bike in your neighborhood. We will begin building safety and access improvements as early as late December 2017 and early January 2018 near Rainier View Elementary. The improvements include marked crossings, curb bulbs, and traffic calming measures such as speed humps.

#### **PROJECT ELEMENTS**

- **51st Ave S and S Bangor St** Curb extensions and ADA ramps on the east side of the intersection.
- **55th Ave S and S Bangor St** Curb extensions, ADA ramps and crosswalk flashing beacons on the west side of the intersection.
- Beacon Ave S and S Leo St Curb extensions and ADA ramps on the east side of the intersection.
- Beacon Ave S and S Avon St Curb extensions, ADA ramps on the east side of the intersection.
- Beacon Ave S and S Augusta St ADA ramps on the east side of the intersection.
- Beacon Ave S and 55th Ave S Curb extensions, ADA ramps, a crosswalk and speed humps, along Beacon Ave S.
- Beacon Ave S & 56th Ave S ADA ramps on the east side of the intersection.
- **S Luther St and 55th Ave S** A curb extension and ADA ramps at the existing school crosswalk.

### SCHEDULE AND FUNDING

This project is moving forward with construction as early as late December 2017 and early January 2018.

The Safe Routes to Schools program is funding project design as well as the education and encouragement programs. The Levy to Move Seattle is funding construction.
