Building a new drainage system to help with flooding in South Park

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) and the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) are working together on the South Park Drainage and Roadway Partnership project to improve flooding and drainage issues in South Park.

Streets will be repaved, and some gravel streets will be upgraded to pavement.
Sidewalks and street trees will be added in some locations.

This project will help reduce flooding by installing new pipes and drains to collect and better manage stormwater (rainwater runoff). This water will eventually be directed to a future water station for

treatment prior to reaching the nearby Duwamish Waterway.



SCHEDULE

This project construction started in mid-October 2021. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of 2022.

LOCATION

This project is in the South Park Industrial Area, between 2nd Ave S and 8th Ave S, extending to S Holden St and S Monroe St.

SOUTH PARK RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES, AND TRAVELERS CAN EXPECT

- Construction Monday through Friday during the day, from approximately 7 AM to 4 PM.
- Construction noise, dirt, vibration, and pavement excavation and removal.
- Increased construction traffic, materials, and large equipment in the area.
- Driveway access to private properties to be maintained.
- Driveways may need to be closed for short time periods during construction. Seattle Public Utilities and the project contractor will coordinate closures with property owners as needed.
- Local access maintained during construction for people who live, work, or visit the area.
