### **Dam Safety and Weekly Test**

- No reported issues with weekly tests
- Monitoring siren performance on site
- Minor earthquake 4/28 not large enough to trigger further action



# **Seismic Safety**

- Dam Safety Monitoring 24/7
- 4 instruments work together to trigger any alarm
- If triggered, SPU 24/7 operators evaluate instruments and cameras at the dam to verify
  - Reservoir level indicator
  - $\,\circ\,$  Buried wire in the crest of the dam
  - $\,\circ\,$  Two river flow measurements in two locations
- Also have accelerometer at the dam. When triggered, would alert operators to verify instruments and cameras, and trigger early warning system if needed.


#### • Earthquake Magnitudes and Actions

• Any earthquake greater than 4.0 magnitude triggers immediate, physical dam inspection.

#### • 4/28 Event

• 2.5 magnitude, not large enough to trigger seismic switch for accelerometer; 4 instruments continued to show normal activity.

- Text alert signup via <u>ALERT King County</u>
- Non-emergency community text alerts workshop
- King County Ofc of Emerg. Mgt. evacuation planning
- Inundation area information

## **Tolt Dam Early Warning System Replacement Project**

- Replace and improve outdated siren and system components.
- Add redundancy, resiliency, and reliability.
- Add signage.
- Listen and respond to community needs and suggestions.
- Develop a consistent design for sirens and tones.





# Signage and Sirens

- Coordinating with: City Manager Jean, Ben Thompson, CM Harris on design (also considering community feedback)
- Replacing 8 sirens at 4 outdoor/4 indoor locations
- Exploring new signs/sirens
  - 3 outdoor sirens
  - 6 digital message signs

#### New Digital Sign

- NE 124  $^{th}$  and SR 203
- Carnation Farm Road and SR203
- NE  $60^{th}$  and SR 203
- Tolt Hill Road and SR203
- SR 202 and SR 203
- New City Hall Alerting Device
- Working through these preliminary locations with Ben Thompson






# Siren Locations (Existing & Potential)

- 🕄 Existing Siren
  - Potential New Siren
    - NE  $60^{th}$  and SR 203
    - Tolt MacDonald Park
    - Tolt River Road and 336<sup>th</sup> (River View Park)

Note: The existing Siren 3 will be moved further northeast along the Tolt River Road.


