Cost: \$20 for infant and youth sizes – all styles
\$30 for teen and adult sizes – all styles

Sizes: Infant, youth, teen, adult small, medium, large, extra large, and XXL.

Why: It's the law: Washington State law requires children ages 12 and younger to wear a Coast Guard approved life jacket or life vest on vessels less than 19 feet in length.

To reduce drownings: Drowning is the second leading cause of unintentional injury death among children ages 1 – 14. Wearing a life jacket saves lives.

Bicycle Helmet Sale

\$10 bicycle and multi-sport helmet sales will be conducted by Seattle Park and Recreation, in cooperation with Cascade Bicycle Club Education Foundation.

Helmets are available for all age groups. Youth younger than 18 years old must be accompanied by a parent or guardian in order to purchase a helmet. State law requires all bicyclists to wear bike helmets while riding.
