Staff Discussion

- Deputy Mayor Tim Ceis and Mayor's Legal Counsel Regina LaBelle answered questions on general issues related to the collective bargaining process and the timeline for the panel's work.

Work Plan Discussion

- Panel requested that an expert be brought in to provide an overview of other police accountability practices around the country.

- Kathryn Olson agreed to provide training reports, including recommendations on the areas upon which she believes training should be focused.
