- 3. Explore reducing fencing along 23rd Ave W at soccer fields















Subdrain Plan





Sports Lawn Soil with Lateral




Lateral to Collector Sub-Drainage













Drainage Plan





Bioretention Pond Width




Bioretention Pond Detail
