What is CCAP?

The Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) provides Seattle families with financial support for child care services.

CCAP pays between

25-70%

of most child care rates for families

WITH CHILDREN YOUNGER THAN 13.

CCAP is expanding

More families are now eligible to receive help.

Recipients must meet the following basic requirements:



Live within
Seattle city
limits



Earn less than
\$90K per year
FOR A FAMILY OF FOUR



Have a child
younger than
13 years old



Employed or
enrolled in school
or job training
