Program Model






Three regions of King County:

Family Caregiver Support Program


Family Caregiver Support Program

- Unpaid caregivers helping someone 18+
- Live in King County
- Not on Medicaid long term care services, live in nursing facility or adult family home

Caregiver Services May Include

- Information, Assistance, and Outreach
- Caregiver Assessment (TCARE®)
- Respite Coordination
- Emergency Respite Coordination
- Counseling
- Support Groups
- Training/Consultation
