CERTIFICATION:

OIG partially certified this investigation on 3/16/2020 noting concerns related to thoroughness: some of the allegations made by the Complainant during the intake interview, which were documented by OPA, were not otherwise followed up on or investigated by OPA.

OIG and OPA met to discuss this investigation on 3/19/2020 and OIG allowed OPA additional time to engage in further efforts to contact the Complainant in an attempt to address the omissions of the investigation. While OIG appreciates the efforts made by OPA, unfortunately, those efforts were not successful. Because OPA was not able to follow up with the Complainant related to the other allegations made during intake, nor did OPA request perishable evidence related to 911 calls, this has left OPA with no further means by which to remedy the missed allegations. Therefore, per 3.29.260 F, no further investigation is being directed at this time.

OIG maintains the certification of this investigation as timely and objective, but not thorough.
