INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

During the investigation of another incident, no In-Car Video of the incident could be identified.

COMPLAINT

The complainant, a supervisor within the Department, alleged that the named employee did not have In-Car-video of an incident.

INVESTIGATION

The OPA investigation included the following actions:

1. Review of the complaint memo
2. Search for and review of all relevant records and other evidence
3. Interview of SPD employee

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

The weight of the evidence showed that the named employee failed to use his In-Car Video system to record his law enforcement actions as required by policy.

FINDINGS

Allegation #1

The evidence showed that the named employee failed to use his In-Car Video system. Therefore a **Sustained** finding was issued for *In Car Video System: Employees Will Record Police Activity*.
