



- Enhance transit access

















Bicycle Facilities Plan




















Mercer Corridor Schedule
























Two-Way Conversion



- Two lanes in each direction on Mercer St (Fifth Ave N Second Ave W)
- One lane each direction on Roy St (Fifth Ave N Queen Anne Ave N)
- Bike lanes on Roy St
- All changes within the existing street right-of-way
- Project coordination: Seattle Center, RapidRide
