



Clean Cities Community Clean Teams Weekly Report

June 10, 2021

Reporting Week May 31 through June 6

Week in Review

Due to the holiday on Monday, there was no work to report on that day for SDOT Clean Cities crew. This week the community clean team focused on two large emphasis areas including David Rogers Park and Kobe Terrace Park, besides the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. 16 additional Clean Cities sites were completed by the Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Teams and 28 additional sites were completed by SDOT crews alone. The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Crews.

By the Numbers:

- 270 needles collected
- 300 lbs. of debris removed during the jamboree clean at Kobe Terrace Park
- 23,740 lbs. trash collected via Community Clean Teams
- 9 blocks of litter pickup by SDOT crews
- 284 tents counted onsite
- 0.45 miles of vegetation management by SDOT crew
- 24 signs of graffiti cleaned

Clean Cities Emphasis Areas

- David Rogers Park: 6/1. Every jamboree starts off with a safety meeting discussing the safety protocols of 6' social distancing, wearing a mask and not sharing tools. CW Districted hosted the David Rogers Jamboree with 7 other districts sending 1 crew member to support the scheduled work. The work consisted of weeding the upper portion of 1st Avenue W. entry beds and mulching them, line trimming and mulching several tree wells. The play area was leveled, and small debris blown and removed.

- Kobe Terrace Park: 6/3. DT District and support from the 7 other districts weeded and line trimmed beds in preparation for mulching. After the beds were cleaned of weeds burlap was laid for weed suppression. Everyone participated in delivering and spreading mulch to the terraced areas of the park. There were several irrigation leaks which the plumber located and repaired.

Field inspections and cleaning of right of way areas will include stairways, multi-use paths, streets, and sidewalks in the immediate vicinity of these parks.
