

DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

Description: **Be'er Sheva Park Improvements** – Seattle Parks and Recreation is proposing improvements at Be'er Sheva Park in Seattle. Improvements include creating a prominent entry that will draw people into the park, enhancing connectivity through the park with new paths, community amenities, and transforming the shoreline into a neighborhood beach destination. New amenities include seating, barbecues, art, a picnic shelter structure, stage with shelter, beach and habitat restoration with native plantings, a new hand carried boat launch, and site lighting for greater shoreline access and improved habitat to benefit juvenile salmonids. The project includes approximately 3,000 cu.yds. of grading.
