




community. The lawn is a great idea for open space but find that big open spaces without any specific program tend to not be used. It would be great to have an area for food trucks to inhabit the outskirts of the space (like they currently operate now). The couple of food trucks in the area are popular, and it'd be great for food trucks to visit here regularly and create a culture around food similar to that of Portland or Austin. Given the isolation we're bound to be in for awhile it'd be great to pair this with some areas of coverage so that the space can be utilized more throughout the year. It would be amazing if the coverage could design could integrate with the open space (think Millennium Park in Chicago, but small scale). If food trucks aren't in the program a similar approach could be taken with a sports program like a mini soccer field or basketball court, although I don't think this would activate the space like a food truck area will. Given this area is the gateway into the neighborhood it will be important that the space is active and inviting; South Park is seen as a dangerous neighborhood so it will be incredibly important to activate this space as much as possible so it doesn't give off the vibe of being empty and isolated (similar vibes can be seen of the skate park off of W Marginal Way S and S Cloverdale St, great amenity but it feels unsafe at night). The yard programmed as-is is a great starting point, but as of now misses an opportunity to activate the space. Also, South Park is seeing a lot more traffic with the closure of the West Seattle Bridge. I frequent the rain gardens on the other side of 14th often and feel unsafe crossing 14th Ave S as well as Dallas Ave S. It would be great if Seattle Parks worked with SDOT to create a pedestrian friendly pathway across 14th Ave S on the north side of the Street as well as across Dallas Ave S (or better yet a 4 way pedestrian crosswalk). Right now you're left dodging traffic across 14th and hoping cars turning onto Dallas will see you. Lastly, we have a couple of festivals during the year with the parking lot south of the park gets utilized. I know this most likely isn't public


