

BALLARD MULTIMODAL CORRIDOR PROJECT

The Ballard Multimodal Corridor Project includes many important transportation and mobility improvements between the Ballard Locks and 11th Ave NW:

- Roadway paving
- Signal improvements
- New transit poles
- New sidewalks and curb ramps
- Storm drainage improvements
- Multi-use trail improvements, including the Burke-Gilman Trail Missing Link

Members of the Ballard community identified this comprehensive package of important roadway improvements during the community design process for the Burke-Gilman Trail Missing Link.

CONSTRUCTION of the Ballard Multimodal Corridor is anticipated to proceed in 2 phases:



MARKET PHASE

SDOT has been conducting early testing work on the Market Phase (between the Ballard Locks and 24th Ave NW) since March 2019. Construction of the Market Phase will begin April 2019 and continue through the year. Additional paving on NW 54th St, behind the Nordic Museum, will also be completed during this initial phase of construction.

SHILSHOLE PHASE

Construction on the **Shilshole Phase** is expected to begin later in 2019.
