## What to expect:

- This work is weather dependent but we're aiming to start the week of May 17 and crews will work intermittently over approximately 2 weeks
- Short-term daytime lane and partial intersection closures (crews will aim to work primarily in the first half of the day when fewer businesses are open)
- Crews will restore 11 rainbow crosswalks with heavier work focused at the intersections of 10th/Pine and 11th/Pine because of the need for more significant repair
