PROJECT UPDATE

We've used community feedback, technical data, and transportation plans to develop a preferred option that redesigns Delridge Way SW to move people safely and efficiently.

In the Delridge corridor, we're proposing:

- Bus lanes
- Landscaped medians
- Crosswalk improvements
- Protected bike lanes
- Neighborhood Greenway connections
- Signal upgrades
- Paving
- Water and sewer pipe upgrades
- Spot parking and bike lane removal
- Public art

Delridge Way SW is one of seven Transit-Plus Multimodal corridors in Seattle. We're working to improve transit speed and reliability in partnership with King County Metro.

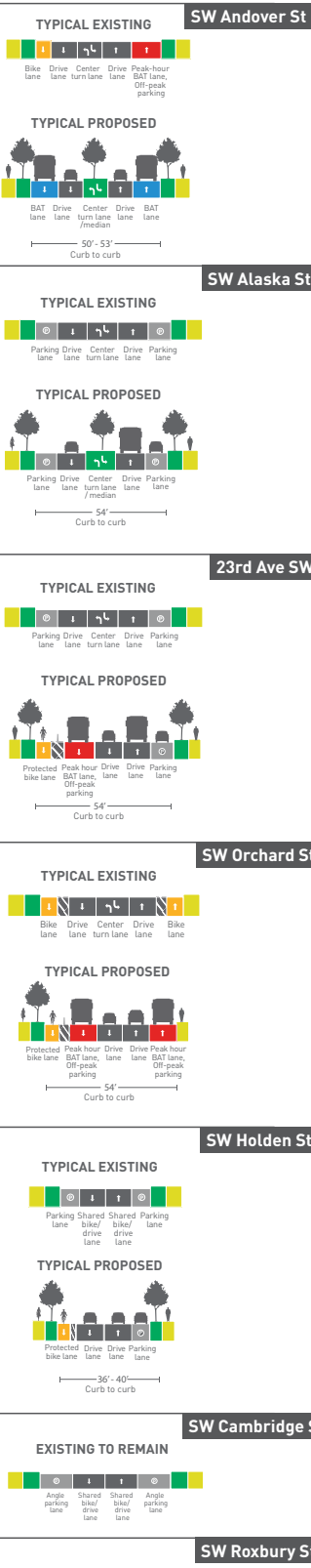
