

**YOU CAN**

- Enjoy your time and create memories.
- Explore the trails and Welcome Center.
- Discover the magic of water.

**DECORATING**

- You are responsible for setup and takedown.
- No balloons or rice.
- Respect the natural landscape.
- No tacks, pins, nails or any other sharp objects. Do not use duct tape or scotch tape.
- Tents must be approved by staff.

**GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES**

- Remove garbage to a facility dumpster. If trash exceeds three 30-gallon bags it must be taken off-site.
- Recycling and composting are required.

**CANDLES, SMOKING, BARBECUES, AND CAMPFIRES**

- Use of candles, barbecues or the campfire circle must be approved in advance of the event. Fires and candles must not be left unattended.
- No smoking anywhere except in designated smoking areas. All cigarettes must be deposited in ashtrays.

**PARKING**

- Parking is allowed in designated areas only.
- Cars cannot be left overnight without making arrangements. Unauthorized cars left overnight will be towed.

**FACILITY**

- Rental may NOT exceed 120 people.
- Children must be supervised at all times. Adult supervision must be designated.
- Leave the facility by the time stated in rental agreement or be liable for additional fees.

**WEAPONS**

- The possession and use of weapons is prohibited.

**FOOD AND ALCOHOL**

- No alcohol is allowed without advance permission.
- A licensed bartender/Class 12 Mixologist must serve alcohol unless:
  - You are only having a ceremonial toast- Limit 1 serving of 4oz per person
  - Officially sponsored and paid for by your business, during work hours. Limit 2 servings of beer or wine per person. Liability Insurance including “Host Liquor Liability,” is required.
- ANY event serving alcohol must have a Banquet Permit from the Washington State Liquor Control Board.
- Personal use of privately provided alcohol except a ceremonial toast is not allowed anywhere on the premises including parking areas and Rattlesnake Lake Area. This includes private flasks, beer, wine, etc.
- Kegs are allowed in outside areas only.
- Alcohol in outside areas must be contained to designated rental areas.
- The user is responsible for communicating rules and supervising guests.
