ESS 18.18

1. Recruit Barbara Beers E18, A/3 will report to duty at Engine 18, on December 13, 1977 on Div. #2. Prior to Beers reporting to duty, the general health and safety standards for fire fighters must be corrected to comply with the standards.
2. The following corrections will be made by the Service Division:
 - A. WAC 296-305-06503 sanitation. 1. Toilet facilities.
 - a. General. Where toilet rooms will be occupied by no more than one person at a time, can be locked from the inside, and contain at least one water closet, separate toilet rooms for each sex need not be provided.

A simple locking device (slide bolt) on the appropriate toilet rooms would comply with the standards as they relate to toilet facilities.
 - B. Showers, except as otherwise indicated in this section, shower rooms separate for each sex shall be provided in manned stations.

Where shower rooms will be occupied by no more than one person at a time and can be locked from the inside, separate shower rooms for each sex need not be provided.

A simple locking device (slide bolt) on the appropriate shower rooms would comply with the standards as they relate to showers.
