



Streetlight Resource Guide

The City of Seattle owns and operates more than 65,000 streetlights which includes illuminated arterials, business districts and residential roadways, as well as walkways, pathways, stairways, and other open areas within the public right-of-way. Billing for all public street lighting is paid for by the City of Seattle's General Fund. There are also nearly 3000 private rental streetlights within the City. These lights have been installed at the specific request of a resident or business owner, and in each case, the customer pays for the lighting through Seattle City Light's rental lighting program.



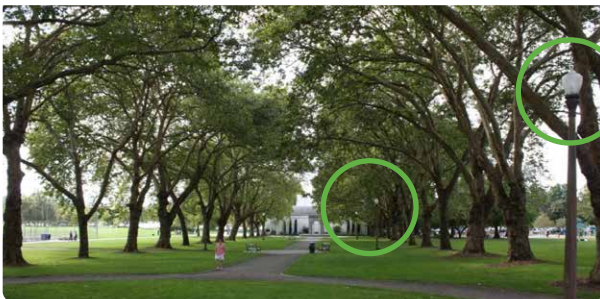
ARTERIAL & NON-ARTERIAL STREETLIGHTS

The City of Seattle's street lighting system consists of illuminated arterials, business districts, and residential roadways within the public right-of-way.

The City of Seattle has park lighting which provides lighting for public parks and is managed by Seattle Parks and Recreation.
