Sound Generations Begins Its Shift to an Electric Vehicle Fleet



Sound Generations has joined Seattle City Light's Fleet Electrification Program.

Sound Generations is a Seattle-based nonprofit organization that runs several community programs. For example, it provides Meals on Wheels and van services for older adults. Interested in reducing costs, the nonprofit has been eager to find an alternative to their fleet of more than 50 gas-powered vehicles.

In early 2022, Sound Generations met with Seattle City Light's electric vehicle (EV) experts to talk about making the switch to an electric fleet. Owning an electric fleet can save a company money and reduce its carbon footprint. Sound Generations, however, still had questions about the exact savings it could expect.

With a few one-on-one support calls, City Light EV experts helped Sound Generations conduct a fleet assessment. This included information on the EV industry and comparisons of different vehicles. The experts also compared the costs and benefits of EVs to the organization's current gas-powered fleet.

The fleet assessment gave Sound Generations a clear road map for fleet electrification. The organization expects to save nearly \$1.7 million in fuel and upkeep costs over the next 27 years by switching to electric. In that same period, the company will have successfully reduced its greenhouse gas emissions by 6,795 metric tons of CO_2 . This is equal to planting over 100,000 trees.

Altogether, Sound Generations is a prime example of how an organization can benefit from electrifying its fleet. With a new EV fleet, this long-running organization will continue to serve the community while reducing costs and helping the environment.
