## Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the Environmental Assessment (EA) of the proposed decommissioning of the Newhalem Creek Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2705-037) (hereafter referred to as the Project), dated March 29, 2024. The 30-day comment period ends on April 29, 2024.

The NPS requests an extension of 14 days or until May 13, 2024. This extension is requested to provide adequate time to consult with the Washington State Historic Preservation Officer and area tribes and accommodate an unusually high workload associated with participating in the Skagit (P-553) relicensing negotiations, addressing issues associated with the Skagit (P-553) license implementation (including the likelihood of not filling Ross reservoir again this year), processing and onboarding seasonal staff, and issuing the record of decision for the North Cascades Grizzly Bear Restoration Environmental Impact Statement. In addition, the review period has also fallen during a period when key staff had leave planned to address urgent family matters.
