Subject: Newhalem Creek Hydroelectric Project Decommission Environmental Assessment

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the Environmental Assessment of the proposed decommissioning of the Newhalem Creek Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2705-037) (hereafter referred to as the Project), dated March 29, 2024. The 30-day comment period ends on April 29, 2024.

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) requests an extension of 14 days or until May 13, 2024 to comment on the Environmental Assessment. This extension is requested to provide adequate time to consult with the National Park Service, Washington State Historic Preservation Officer, and area tribes. Additionally, an extension would accommodate an unusually high workload associated with participating in the Skagit Hydroelectric Project (P-553) relicensing settlement negotiations and addressing issues associated with the Skagit Hydroelectric Project (P-553) license implementation (including the likelihood of not filling Ross reservoir again this year).

Finally, stakeholders, including the USFWS, have also been invited to discuss aspects of the Project decommissioning (i.e., tailrace barrier and access road) with Seattle City Light on April 30, 2024; outcomes from this meeting may affect our position and comments related the preferred alternative.
