Background Overview



History of OII



Gov. Jay Inslee created the Governor's Task Force on Independent Investigations of Police Use of Force Inslee signed police accountability legislative package. Inslee announced members of OII Advisory Board. Agency development, branding, and recruitment began. Inslee names OII Director Roger Rogoff OII is actively creating policies and protocols, recruiting, training, and conducting public outreach, and accepting review for prior investigations

OII is not currently investigating any newly occurring cases

All investigations of police use of force will be free from bias and trusted by everyone.

Operations

By statute RCW 43.102, OII will:

Conduct criminal investigations of law enforcement use of deadly force.

Be independent of any other agency or prosecuting office.

Conduct investigation with competent, experienced, independent investigators



Operations

By statute RCW 43.102, OII will:

Start by investigating fatal cases only.

Investigate prior investigations with new evidence.

Refer investigation summary and case files to the prosecutorial authority. OII will not make charging recommendations. The case summary will also be publicly available.




Key Roles by the numbers
