

Information Regarding Requesting The Court to Vacate A Default Judgment Because of Identity Theft

Seattle Municipal Court has created this packet of information to assist you when you believe that, as a result of having your identity stolen, you were wrongly identified as a person who committed an infraction. This packet includes the following:

1. A copy of Infraction Rule For Courts of Limited Jurisdiction (IRLJ) 6.7(b) which sets forth the procedure for review of motions to vacate a default judgment based upon misidentification due to identity theft.
2. Instructions regarding filing and serving a DECLARATION REQUESTING THE COURT TO VACATE JUDGMENT DUE TO MISTAKEN IDENTITY.
3. An uncompleted DECLARATION REQUESTING THE COURT TO VACATE JUDGMENT DUE TO MISTAKEN IDENTITY. You must complete, serve and file this form following the instructions in this packet. Please note that knowingly providing false information in this Declaration may subject you to criminal charges for perjury.
