REMINDERS

Per IRS rules, unreimbursed/unused Dependent Care (daycare) FSA funds are not eligible for carryover. For Healthcare FSA, up to \$680 of unreimbursed/unused funds from the 2025 plan year will carry over and be added to the 2026 FSA reelection. **If no re-election is made** for the Healthcare FSA, only unreimbursed/unused funds between \$120 and \$680 will carry over. Balances of less than \$120 (when there is no re-election into the following plan year) are not eligible for carryover and will be forfeited.
