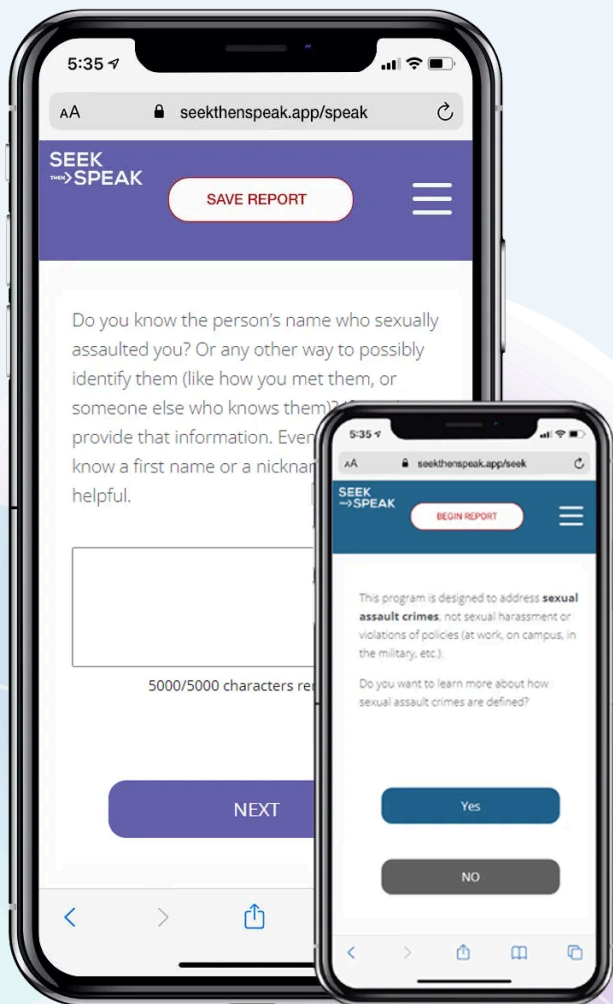


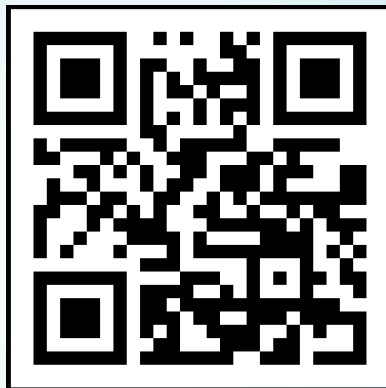

SEEK: EXPLORE OPTIONS

In SEEK, survivors can privately gather information and consider next steps.

Topics include:

- Sexual Assault
- Crime Victim Rights
- Victim Advocacy
- Medical Care / Forensic Exams
- Reporting to Police

SEEK is designed to address real-world questions that survivors are likely to have.

An additional section of SEEK is designed for support people, with concrete tips on how to respond and support survivors.

SPEAK: BEGIN REPORTING

Begin the process of reporting your sexual assault in SPEAK, a self-guided interview.

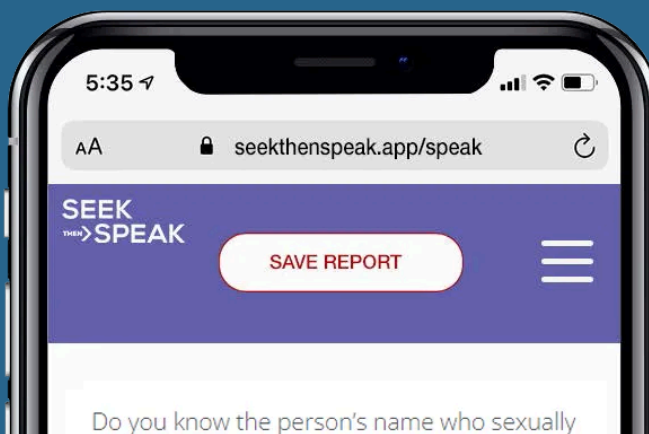
HOW IT WORKS:

- Complete the interview at your own pace, at a time and place that feels right for you.
- Once finished, the program generates a downloadable pdf that you can:
 - Save or print for your own records
 - Email to law enforcement

To submit your report to Seattle Police Department, email the pdf to:
SEEKTHENSPEAK@SEATTLE.GOV

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT:

- After you submit your report, advocate will be in touch to follow up.
- Police will review your report and may open an investigation to determine what crimes were committed based on state law and evidence available.



SEEK THEN > SPEAK ABOUT THE TOOL

ACCESSIBLE:

- Free to use, available on any digital device.
- User-friendly interface enhances accessibility.
- Translated into a wide range of languages.

SURVIVOR-CENTERED:

- You are in control each step of the way.
- You can provide as much or as little info as you want, and take as much time as you need.
- You decide if and when you want to report.

TRAUMA-INFORMED:

- Prompts replicate the investigative interview done by a law enforcement officer trained in sexual assault victimization and trauma.

CONFIDENTIAL:

- For your privacy, the site will prompt you to clear your data after downloading your report to ensure that your information is kept private.
