An agency is allowed to submit its own application for one or more service areas, and, within the same application, enlist partners in any of the service areas. The <u>Seattle Food Committee</u> (SFC) and <u>Meals Partnership Coalition</u> (MPC) are networks that represent a collective of food banks and meal programs and have decades of history in Seattle. Previously known as the emergency food system, these networks act as the social safety net for food security in the city. Both networks meet monthly to share resources and host trainings.
