



Seattle Youth Employment Program (SYEP) ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION CHECKLIST 2023

You must provide proof for each of the three categories: household income, age, and current address. *Legible copies of original documents are accepted and preferred.*

<u>Some documents can cover two requirements!</u> For example, free/reduced lunch letter can prove income **AND** address. State ID can prove age AND address. Review your documents carefully!

Proof of Income or Public Assistance (must show parent/guardian name on document if living with them)	
Public Assistance:	
2022 or 2023 Free and Reduced Lunch Award Letter <i>OR</i>	
2022 or 2023 DSHS Letter for TANF or SNAP Benefits <i>OR</i>	
2022 or 2023 Washington Apple Health Benefit Letter (or Apple Health Card – Molina, United, etc.) <i>OR</i>	
2022 or 2023 SCL/SPU bill with utility discount applied	
Household Income (all adult household members must provide proof of income):	
Household 2021 or 2022 Income Tax Return <i>OR</i>	
2022 or 2023 Pension Letter OR	
2022 or 2023 Social Security Administration Benefits Letter <i>OR</i>	
2022 or 2023 1 month of paystubs (must show dates paid, payee's name and gross income) OR	
Unemployment Benefits Document dated within the last six months <i>OR</i>	
Letter from School Counselor or Agency case manager stating knowledge of household income <i>OR</i>	
SYEP Declaration of No Income form	

Proof of Age (no expired proof of age allowed)	
State ID or Driver's License <i>OR</i>	
Valid U.S. Passport <i>OR</i>	
Permanent Resident Card (aka green card) OR	
Birth Certificate	

Proof of Address (must show parent/guardian name if living with them)	
Home Utility Bill <i>OR</i>	
Copy of Lease or Mortgage <i>OR</i>	
Current Cable Bill OR	
Official Mail from Federal, State, or City Agency <i>OR</i>	
Unofficial school transcript with address listed <i>OR</i>	
Other proof you are attending Seattle Public Schools or a Seattle College (North, Central, South)
