Other Important Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Led by SYEP's youth development counselors (YDC). Participants can receive feedback on their career portfolio (resume, cover letter, etc.) May also have the opportunity to attend career development workshops, job shadow, and do informational interviews with professionals within their chosen career field. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This track is a partnership with Computing For All (CFA). Designed for those with zero to minimal software development experience, youth will start at Level 1 and learn the basics. Equipment such as a laptop and more can be provided for youth who need them. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Youth will do paid volunteer work at a hospital department throughout the program. <u>Week 1 - 4</u>: Zoom classes (online) and skills labs (in-person) <u>Week 5</u>: Makeup/Preparation and clinical orientation (in-person) <u>Week 6</u>: Clinical work experience (in-person) <u>After</u>: Take the NA-C (Nursing Assistant Certification) state skills exam and written test. Guaranteed job interview at Swedish.
