After additional analysis of the litter patrol data and statements from Seattle police officers and park rangers who patrol the AIA and parks located in the AIA, I support and request that the product **Big Bear** be added to the other products: **Joose, Tilt Green, Camo Black Ice, Evil Eye, Sparks Plus, Icehouse, Maximum Ice, and Johnny Bootlegger.**

Seattle business and community groups have also identified these products as problematic, especially with chronic public inebriates.
