## **Relevant Guidelines:**

4. Building Materials and Fixtures – Board to consider whether the proposed style, materials, and overall aesthetic of a scissor-style gate are compatible with the storefront and the district.

### Additional relevant information:

- The staff recommended that the applicant first consult with the board on a scissor gate given that these gates have typically been discouraged it the past.
- In recent years, applicants across the district have described security issues and presented various solutions to the board. Some recent examples of boardapproved security measures have been interior curtain-style gates in windows, a bollard, and reinforcements on a door.
- Many of the scissor gates in the sample photos provided by the applicant have not been reviewed or approved by the board. While this is not a reflection on the applicant, it highlights an opportunity for the board to think about the gates and provide guidance and direction for this and other future applicants moving forward.
