070325.2 APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL

Ryan Robbins, Business Owner

Proposal to re-paint the front of the building and paint the business name on the building exterior.

Staff provided photos of the existing storefront, renderings of the proposed work, building paint information, and signage design details. Staff cited guidelines: 5 Building Surface Materials; 13 Signs.

Ryan Robins presented the proposal, providing clarification that the proposal was being modified to use gold paint instead of gold leaf on the lettering of the business sign.

The property owner was not in attendance.

The board found that the proposed exterior building painting was consistent with District guidelines, but the proposed business signage was disproportionately large in relation to the rest of the storefront.

Action: Tommy Patrick made a motion to approve the application with the following amendment: the total width of the business name signage must be reduced to the width of the exterior entryway. Philipp Koman seconded the motion.

Proposal for a new blade sign and window decal signage.

Staff provided photos of the existing storefront, renderings of the proposed work, sign design and attachment details. Staff cited guidelines: 7 Transparency; 13(a) Sign Materials; 13 (b) Storefront Signs; 13(c) Blade Signs.

Mike Duehning and Leslie Bamburg presented the proposal, providing clarification regarding the proposed small text on the door and front windows.

The property owner was not in attendance.

The board found that the proposed blade sign was consistent with District guidelines, but the proposed window decal signage was incompatible due to its materiality and redundancy.

Action: Tommy Patrick made a motion to approve the application with the following amendments: all window work except "use other door", baby registry information, and door signage must be painted onto the glass rather than applied as decals; the "Aldea" lettering in the front window will be eliminated; the "available franchising" lettering in the front window will be eliminated, the social media handles on the door will be eliminated, the credit card acceptance logos on the door will be eliminated; the Ballard Alliance advertising will be moved to the sidelight window next to the door, the circular logo in the lower portion of the door will be modified to incorporate the business's QR code. Philipp Koman seconded the motion.
