

POST ALLEY - PHARMACY WINDOWS



SITE OBSERVATION:

THERE ARE 5 FULL HEIGHT WINDOWS ALONG POST ALLEY. FOUR BELONG TO PHARMACY/ LOBBY. ALL WINDOWS APPEAR TO BE DECENT CONDITION

PROPOSED SOLUTION:

ADD ORNAMENTAL IRON BARS
FOR SECURITY. PROPOSED
COVERAGE IS TO COVER
TWO THIRDS OF THE HEIGHT
- APPROXIMATELY 8' FROM
GROUND PLANE TO SECURE
ELEVATION. DESIGN TO REGISTER
HORIZONTALLY WITH TOP OF
ENTRANCE OPENNING.

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
ORNAMENTAL IRON (WINDOW GUARDS)





Additional information:

Proposed window guard scope addresses ongoing security concerns at Neighborcare's pharmaceutical clinic. The 5 windows are at ground level and slightly obscure to public surveillance on Post Alley which poses a security risk to the building. The proposed window guards will be painted and designed to match existing window guards prevalent on the northwest façade (refer to photos attached). Additionally, there are numerous pre-existing window guards installed along Post Alley on neighboring building facades. Proposed window guards are to be installed within the recess so as to not obstruct or protrude into alley right of way. The 5 windows to be secured are not egress, nor are they operable rendering a retractable design feature(s) obsolete.
