PIONEER SQUARE OR OCCIDENTAL AVENUE

Past Examples

- Throughout each All-Star Week, MLB aims to incorporate art displays throughout the host city to tie in thematic narratives and Baseball history.
- The mural program can help bring attention to <u>local businesses</u>, Baseball historical figures such as <u>Black trailblazers</u>, and cultural milestones like the <u>Negro Leagues being cemented as a Major</u> <u>League</u>.
- Murals have the opportunity to weave important storytelling and community initiatives into live, interactive art and event activations.









Content

- The content for the wall this year will focus on MLB All-Star legends from the Seattle Mariners
- Around 5 figures will be illustrated
- Diversity of players will be very important (Ichiro, Griffey, Edgar Martinez, etc.)
- Focus on the city of Seattle and it's rich baseball history
- Mixing in modern elements and future focus (TBD city connect Nike uniforms as an example)





Material Considerations

Option 1 - Painted Mural to cover the graffiti

This would be a permanent solution to cover the current graffiti and beautify this area.

Will coordinate local painting crew to remedy any tagging within 24 hours of occurence.

Option 2 - Vinyl adhesive graphic

This option might not work in some areas since the wall has very large holes. We would look to repair parts of the wall if this is the suggested option.

There should not be any residue left after removal, but will coordinate with installation team to ensure wall is left as it was found.



Timeline

- Painting or install of canvas would start mid June
- Around July 6th completion of mural and unveil
- July 7th start of MLB All-Star Week
- July 11th MLB All-Star Game
