


Transportation Management Plan Summary

Transportation Management Plan Elements

TMP Requirements (SMC 23.69.030.F, 23.54.016.C)

- Overview of campus access/circulation
- Summary of connections to adjacent transit and pedestrian facilities
- Definition of proposed campus parking
- Summary of loading and service facilities
- Identification of single occupancy vehicle (SOV) targets
- Strategies to reduce SOV trips

TMP SOV Reduction Focus Areas



SOV Target – 50%

1. Transit

Focuses on incentives such as:

- subsidies
- guaranteed ride home
- transit service priorities
- future light rail infrastructure

2. Shared-Use Transportation

Focuses on:

- carpool/vanpool incentives (subsidies, preferred parking, etc.)
- promotion
- matching support

3. Parking Management

- Manage parking through pricing and parking supply
- Goal to provide adequate supply for patients and visitors, while not providing a surplus that encourages employees to drive, or not enough parking that results in increased neighborhood spill over
- On-going monitoring of parking supply as part of the CTR survey process (every 2 years) or at the time of future project development

4. Bicycle

- Currently a low mode choice on the campus
- Strategies focus on encouraging increased use
- Provide ample campus parking as determined through monitoring studies completed as part of the CTR survey process
- Accommodate e-bike charging in secured areas
- Provide shower and changing facilities as needed based on demand

5. Pedestrian

Provide safe and accessible routes on campus and to the adjacent public right-of way

- ADA requirements
- Lighting
- Connections to on-campus transit

6. Marketing and Education

- Provide multiple platforms and opportunities for understanding incentives
- Facilitate connections for vanpool/carpool usage

7. Telecommuting

- Limited opportunities due to HIPA requirements and the nature of health care
- Offered as applicable

8. Institutional Policies

- Parking regulations
- Manage work schedules where possible to reduce peak hour travel


9. Monitoring and Evaluating

- Participate in CTR survey and annual reporting requirements
- Conduct vehicle and bicycle demand studies along with the CTR report
